	About Color-coded Alerts:  ■ IMD uses a color-coded alert system to indicate the severity of heat conditions:  □ Green Alert: the weather is normal.  □ Yellow Alert (Be Aware): Indicates severe heat but not extreme conditions. Public awareness is advised.  □ Orange Alert (Be Prepared): Warns of hot weather that could impact significantly, requiring preparations for potential health risks.  □ Red Alert (Take Action): Issued when extremely hot conditions are expected, posing a risk of health emergencies. Immediate action and intervention are necessary.

### **Boundaries:**

- Northern and northeastern boundaries contiguous with Sikkim and Bhutan respectively.
- Links Pangolakha Wildlife Sanctuary in Sikkim and Toorsa Strict Reserve in Bhutan.
- Southern boundaries connect with Jalpaiguri district forests, joining Chapramari Wildlife Sanctuary and Gorumara National Park.

## **Geographical Features:**

- Rachela Pass marks the highest point.
- Incorporates traits of Himalayan Montane System, Indian Peninsular Sub-region, and Malayan sub-region.

## **Habitat Types:**

- Subtropical Mixed Broadleaf Forest.
- Lower Temperate Evergreen Forest.
- Upper Temperate Mixed Broadleaf Forest.
- Rhododendron Forest.

## Vegetation:

Includes Dry Mixed Forest, Wet Mixed Forest, Lauraceous Forest, Bak-Oak Forest, High-Level Oak Forest, Coniferous Forest, and Himalayan Moist Temperate Forest.

### Flora:

Diverse vegetation such as rhododendron, bamboo, oak, ferns, and sal.

### Fauna:

Home to various species like the Red Panda, Himalayan Tahr, Himalayan Black Bear, Sambar, Barking Deer, Serow, Goral, Dhole, and Gaur.

# Article 131

### Context:

• The Centre informed the Supreme Court that the CBI is not under the control of the Union of India.

## **Key points:**

 This statement was made in response to West Bengal's lawsuit over CBI investigations after the state withdrew its consent in November 2018.

- Tushar Mehta, representing the Centre, highlighted the misuse of Article 131 in the lawsuit filed by West Bengal.
- The Centre raised objections to the lawsuit, arguing that Article 131 should not be misused or abused.
- The Centre clarified that the cases mentioned in the state's suit were not filed by the Union of India but by the CBI, which operates independently.

### Article 131:

### Jurisdiction:

 Supreme Court (SC) has exclusive and original jurisdiction over legal issues between States or between States and the Union.

### **Original Jurisdiction:**

• The power of the court to hear and determine a dispute in the first instance.

# **Article 131 Highlights:**

SC has original jurisdiction in disputes:

- Between the Government of India and one or more States.
- Between the Government of India and any State or States on one side and one or more other States on the other
- Between two or more States, if the dispute involves a question on which the existence or extent of a legal right depends.

### **Nature of Article 131:**

- Limited to disputes involving legal rights, not political nature, unless legal rights are at stake.
- SC's Interpretation:
- 'State' under Article 131 does not include private citizens, companies, or government departments, even if they file a complaint with State Governments.

## **Restrictions:**

- Original jurisdiction of the SC does not extend to disputes arising from treaties, agreements, covenants, etc., before the Constitution's commencement.
- Parliament may exclude SC's jurisdiction in disputes related to inter-state river water use, distribution, or control.
- Suits brought by private individuals against the Government of India are not under SC's original jurisdiction.

### Sri Sarada Math

### Context:

- Pravrajika Anandaprana, the fifth president of Sri Sarada Math and Ramakrishna Sarada Mission, passed away at 97 due to age-related ailments.
- PM Narendra Modi praised her monumental service to society and inculcating spiritual values among people. He also mentioned her efforts in healthcare, education, and empowering Nari Shakti.
- CM Mamata Banerjee expressed her sadness and offered her condolences to the millions of devotees across the world.

# **Key points:**

- Born in 1927 in Bihar, she joined the order as a monk in 1957, receiving brahmacharya vows in 1962 and monk ordination in 1967.
- She was known for her teaching at Sister Nivedita School and later took charge of Ramakrishna Sarada Mission Nivedita Vidyapith.
- She was appointed as a trustee of Sri Sarada Math and a member of the governing body of the Ramakrishna Sarada Mission in April 2017 and was elected president from Jan 14, 2023, onwards.
