





#### Why in news?

• The endangered Iberian lynx population doubles in 3 years.

#### About the Iberian lynx:

- Endemic Carnivore Species:
  - One of two carnivore species endemic to Europe (the other being European mink, Mustela lutreola).
  - The world's most endangered carnivore.
- **Sexually dimorphic**: males are heavier and longer than females.
- Behavior:
  - Generally **nocturnal**.
  - Activity patterns closely synchronized with those of their major prey, the rabbit.
- Distribution:
  - Once distributed throughout the **Iberian Peninsula**.
  - Now sparsely distributed in **Spain** and **Portugal**.
- Conservation Status:
  - IUCN Red List: Endangered.
  - CITES: Appendix II.


