As many as 4 ICAR institutes rear over 2,500 Hilsa in ponds	 Context: Four institutes affiliated with the Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR) have achieved a significant milestone in breeding Hilsa fish. They have collectively reared over 2,500 Hilsa in ponds spread across three districts in West Bengal. This accomplishment raises promising prospects for the captive cultivation of Hilsa, a popular and commercially vital fish facing declining populations. The largest Hilsa reared in these ponds weighed a noteworthy 689 grams after three years. The project involved multiple ponds in North 24 Parganas (Rahara and Kalyani), South 24 Parganas (Kakdwip) and East Midnapore (Kolaghat). Also, some of the Hilsa achieved breeding success in captivity.
	 About: The Hilsa, also known as llish, is a revered fish native to the coastal waters of the Indian Ocean and the Bay of Bengal. It is particularly abundant in the Padma River (a distributary of the Ganges) in Bangladesh, which supplies a staggering 86% of the world's Hilsa.
