	 About NSA: Role and Position: The National Security Advisor (NSA) is the chief advisor to the Prime Minister of India on national security policy and international affairs. Establishment: The position was established in 1998 by the Government of India. Reporting: The NSA reports directly to the Prime Minister and is a key figure in the formulation of security policies. Key Functions: Chairing the National Security Council (NSC), which is responsible for advising the Prime Minister on national security and strategic interests.

Nagarahole Tiger Reserve	 Why in the news? An elephant that participated in the historic Mysuru Dasara celebrations recently passed away due to electrocution. The incident occurred near the Nagarahole Tiger Reserve in Karnataka.
	 About Nagarahole Tiger Reserve: Location: Located in the Kodagu (Coorg) and Mysore districts of Karnataka. Establishment: Established as a wildlife sanctuary in 1955 and declared a tiger reserve in 1999 under Project Tiger. The name 'Nagarahole' translates to 'serpent stream' in Kannada, named after a small river that flows through the park. The reserve is part of the Western Ghats, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, and forms a critical connecting habitat for tigers and elephants to other areas of the Western Ghats through the Brahmagiri Wildlife Sanctuary and to the Eastern Ghats through the Bandipur Tiger Reserve.
