In News:

Income scheme for women investment not expenditure.

- TN Chief Minister MK Stalin said, the welfare scheme, Kalaignar Magalir Urimai Thogai (basic income scheme) will pave the way for women's empowerment.
- This scheme is launched in view of the birth anniversary of Dravida Munnetra Kazhagam (DMK) founder CN Annadurai.

Key Points:

- The Kalaignar Magalir Urimai Thogai (KMUT) scheme is a basic income scheme that provides a monthly financial assistance of ₹1,000 to eligible women heads of families in Tamil Nadu.
- The scheme was launched by Chief Minister M.K. Stalin on September 15, 2023.
- To be eligible for the scheme, a woman must be the head of her family, be a resident of Tamil Nadu, and have a monthly income of less than Rs10,000.

Person in News: CN Annadurai

Key points:

- C. N. Annadurai, popularly known as Anna, was an Indian politician who served as the fourth and last Chief Minister of Madras State from 1967 until his death in 1969.
- He was the founder of the Dravida Munnetra Kazhagam (DMK), a Dravidian political party in Tamil Nadu.
- Annadurai was born on September 15, 1909, in Conjeevaram, Madras Presidency.
- He was educated at Pachaiyappa's College, Madras, where he studied law. After graduating, he worked as a


In News: 'Bharat' stamp on road safety

- India has announced its own crash test protocol.
- It is called Bharat New Car Assessment Programme (BNCAP).
- India now became the fifth country in the world to have its own crash test rating structure.
- It lessens India's dependency on overseas agencies which levy 4x the cost.

Key points:

- BNCAP was formulated by the Ministry of Road Transport and Highways with the help of Global NCAP.
- The Automotive Research Association of India, the leading R&D organization in the country, is its testing agency.
- Bharat NCAP's testing protocol is aligned with the global crash test protocols. This implies that the programme will give a star rating between 1-5 for cars tested, with 1 being the lowest

Pallava Temple



- Thiruppulivanam, close to Uthiramerur, is home to an ancient and historical temple for Siva, worshiped here as Vyaghrapurishwara.
- This temple dates back to the Pallava era as seen from evidence provided by inscriptions.



- The original Pallava structure, perhaps of brick, appears to have been rebuilt of granite in the reign of Kulottunga Chola I (1070-1125 A.D.).
- The temple faces east with a three-tier gopuram at the entrance.
- Outside the gopuram are the Nandi mandapam,

	 Key Points: The International Maritime Boundary Line (IMBL) is a conceptual division of the Earth's water surface areas that define the maritime zones and limits of two adjacent countries' sovereignty. This is done through a series of agreements and treaties between the countries involved.
	In India, the IMBL is defined by a number of agreements and treaties with neighboring countries, including: 1. The India-Sri Lanka Maritime Boundary Agreement of 1974
