Key Points: It is designed to detect metals in soil and water According to the ministry of jalshakti ,The water sources of more than 36,000 rural households in India are affected by fluoride, arsenic and heavy metals. Due to the heavy metals in the soil affects salinity which in turn affects the quality of the soil. Also, it reduces the productivity of agricultural lands and affects human health. 	 The NIA is responsible for investigating and prosecuting offenses relating to terrorism, as defined in the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967.
	 Did you know? The NIA also has the power to investigate scheduled offenses under the Indian Penal Code, such as murder, culpable homicide not amounting to murder, dacoity, and kidnapping.
