1) ANS d) 105

105 constitutional amendments have been made in the Constitution of India. The First Constitution Amendment Act was enacted in 1950. 105th Amendment Act was enacted in 2021. The objective of the 105th Constitutional Amendment Act was to restore the ability of state governments to recognize socially and educationally backward persons belonging to other backward classes(OBC)

## 2) ANS **d) 53**

There are a total of 53 international cricket grounds in India. The Prime Minister of India will lay the foundation stone for the new International Cricket Stadium in Varanasi, Uttar Pradesh on 23rd September, 2023. The first ODI in India was played in 1981 at the Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel Stadium in Ahmedabad. The first T20I in India was played in 2007 at the Brabourne Stadium in Mumbai.

## 3) ANS b) Veeramuthuvel

ISRO mission director Veeramuthuvel has won the Vigyan Pratibha Award for the year 2023. He is the director of the Chandrayaan-3 project. The award was given at the 10th Science Fair in Bhopal, Madhya Pradesh. Chief Architect of Vande Bharat Project Suthansu Mani and Dr. Rama Jayasunder of Delhi AIIMS Hospita was also received the Vigyan Pratibha Award for the year 2023.

## 4) ANS c) September 22

World Rhino Day, observed annually on September 22nd, is a global initiative aimed at raising awareness about the critical plight of the rhinoceros species and advocating for their protection.













## 5) ANS d) August 23, 2023

August 23rd is the historic day when Vikram Lander landed on the moon. India became the first country landed on the South Pole of the Moon. Pragyaan rover, which came from the Vikram lander began its explorations on August 23 and ended on September 3. Due to the changes in temperature ,rover went into sleep mode on the 4th of September. ISRO mentioned that rover will resume operations from September 22 when the sun light falls on the moon.

## 6)ANS a) Antim Panghal

Antim Panghal has won bronze medal in the women's 53 kg category at the 2023 World Wrestling Championships in Serbia. This makes Antim Pangal was the 5th woman won a medal in World Wrestling Championships .The other four were Geeta Phogat (2012- Bronze), Babita Kumari (2012- Bronze), Pooja Dhanda (2018 -Bronze ) and Vinesh Phogat (2019,2022- Bronze).

## 7)ANS c) 2013

Renowned Bharatanatyam artist Saroja Vaidyanathan passed away at the age of 86. She made significant contributions to Bharatanatyam and Carnatic music. She was awarded Padma Shri in 2002 and Padma Bhushan in 2013 by the Government of India.

## 8)ANS d) February 28

National Science Day is celebrated every year on 28 February to mark the discovery of the 'Raman Effect' by Sir C.V. Raman on 28 February 1928. The Government of India has come out with a new set of National Awards in the field of Science, Technology and Innovation known as "Rashtriya Vigyan Puraskar". The objective of the Rashtriya Vigyan Puraskar (RVP) is to recognize the notable and inspiring contribution made by the scientists, technologists, and innovators individually or in teams in various fields of science, technology and technology-led innovation.

The awards shall be given in following four categories:-











- Vigyan Ratna (VR) award will recognize lifetime achievements & contributions made in any field of science and technology.
- Vigyan Shri (VS) award will recognize distinguished contributions in any field of science and technology.
- Vigyan Yuva-Shanti Swarup Bhatnagar (VY-SSB) award will recognize & encourage young scientists up to the age of 45 years who made an exceptional contribution in any field of science and technology.
- Vigyan Team (VT) award to be given to a team comprising of three or more scientists or researchers or innovators who have made an exceptional contribution working in a team in any field of science and technology.

9) ANS a) **Ministry of Education and Skill Development and Entrepreneurship** The Ministry of Education and Skill Development and Entrepreneurship launched the Skill on Wheels program. The main objective of this program is to improve the employability of the rural youth and prepare them to face the challenges of the future job market. The project is a joint initiative of National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC) and IndusInd Bank.
