



More women Odhuvars in T.N. temples	 In the last 28 months, 10 women Odhuvars have been appointed in various TN temples.
	 Key facts Odhuvar is a Tamil word which has its root in the Tamil term odhal, which means recitation. Literally, the word odhuvar would refer to a person who recites. However, in the Tamil Saiva tradition, the word would normally refer to devotional singers in Saivite temples, who are in the service of deities by singing their praise through the pathigams.
	 Did you know? Odhuvars sing the devotional songs composed by the Saivite saints, like Karaikkal Ammayar, irunavukkarasar, Tirugnanasambandar and Sundaramurthy Nayanar. The works of the latter three saints, taken together, are known as Thevaram. They lived and composed the songs, set them to music, as also sang them in the Siva temples between the 6th and 9th centuries.
Recent tiger deaths in Nilgir	 In News: National Tiger Conservation Authority (NTCA) officials visited Nilgiris to investigate recent tiger deaths. 10 tigers (six cubs and four adults) had died in Nilgiris forest division and the Mudumalai Tiger Reserve. According to NTCA sources, 145 tiger deaths have been reported across the country so far this year. Out of 145 deaths, 11 tiger deaths were reported in MTR, two in Sathymangalam Tiger Reserve (STR) and one in Srivilliputhur Megamalai Tiger Reserve in Tamil Nadu.

National Tiger Conservation Authority	 Key facts about NTCA National Tiger Conservation Authority (NTCA) is a statutory body under the Ministry of Environment, Forests and Climate Change. It was established in 2005 following the recommendations of the Tiger Task Force. It was constituted under enabling provisions of the Wildlife (Protection) Act, 1972, as amended in 2006, for strengthening tiger conservation, as per powers and functions assigned to it.
40 per cent of EVs sold in India are made in TN	 Key facts: As per the latest data, 40% of electric vehicles sold in India this year (January to September) were manufactured in TN. Did you know? 6 TN cities identified to become e-vehicle hubs. Chennai, Coimbatore, Tiruchi, Madurai, Salem, and Tirunelveli have been identified for developing as electric vehicle hubs.
