1) ANS d)128th Constitution Amendment Bill

The 128th Constitutional Amendment Bill providing for 33% reservation for women in the Lok Sabha and the State Legislatures was passed in the Lok Sabha and the Rajya Sabha on 20 and 21 September. The bill is called the Nari Shakti Vandan Adiniyam (Empowerment of Women) Act. This is the first bill to be passed in the new Parliament. When the Bill becomes law, the membership of the Lok Sabha will increase from 82 to 181. The bill would also impose retrospective reservation on the basis of census data and is unlikely to come into effect for the 2024 Lok Sabha elections.

2) ANS **a) One**

Indian women's cricket team won a gold medal at the Asian Games for the first time. Cricket was introduced to the Asian Games in 2010. The Indian men's and women's cricket teams are participating in the 19th Asian Games 2023 for the first time. The women's cricket team won the gold medal by defeating Sri Lanka by 19 runs in the final.

3) ANS **d) 34**

A total of 25 Vande Bharat Express trains will be running in India till August 2023. The Prime Minister of India inaugurated nine more Vande Bharat trains on 24th September. These new Vande Bharat trains are a step towards realising Prime Minister's vision of improving connectivity across the country and providing world class facilities to rail passengers. These nine trains will boost connectivity across eleven states namely Rajasthan, Tamil Nadu, Telangana, Andhra Pradesh, Karnataka, Bihar, West Bengal, Kerala, Odisha, Jharkhand and Gujarat. In line with the Prime Minister's vision to improve connectivity of important religious places across the country, Rourkela- Bhubaneswar – Puri Vande Bharat Express and Tirunelveli-Madurai- Chennai Vande Bharat Express will connect important religious towns of Puri and Madurai. Also, the Vijayawada – Chennai Vande

Bharat Express will operate via the Renigunta route and will provide connectivity to Tirupati Pilgrimage centre.

4) ANS b) Thanjavur

State finance minister of Tamil Nadu announced that Work on establishing the Grand Chola Museum in Thanjavur will commence soon. The museum will be dedicated to the Chola dynasty, which ruled over Tamil Nadu and parts of South India from the 9th to the 13th centuries. The museum will be built on a 20-acre plot of land near the Thanjavur Big Temple, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. The museum will house a wide range of artifacts from the Chola period, including sculptures, bronzes, inscriptions, and coins.

5) ANS c)Tamil Nadu

Tamil Nadu is nearing its goal of becoming a hub for electric vehicle manufacturing. 10 lakh electric vehicles were sold in India. Of the vehicles sold, 4 lakh were electric vehicles manufactured in Tamil Nadu. The Government of Tamil Nadu expects to invest over Rs. 50,000 crore in the electric vehicle manufacturing sector by 2025. By 2030, Tamil Nadu aims to manufacture 30% of all electric vehicles sold in India and contribute significantly to global exports.

6)ANS a) Perumal Murugan

Ramnath Goenka Sahitya Samman Award 2023 awarded to Perumal Murugan for outstanding contribution to Tamil literature.

7)ANS c)Nilgiris

Mukkurthi National Park is located in the Nilgiris district of Tamil Nadu. Nilgiri Tahr is an animal endemic to the region so the park was earlier known as the Nilgiri Thar National Park which is the English name of Praiyat .The area was upgraded as a wildlife sanctuary on 3rd August 1982 and then as a National Park on 15th October 1990 . The Tamil Nadu Forest Department has also taken steps to protect the area's precious wildlife in response to poaching incidents in the Mukkurthi National Park.
