### 1) ANS b) Bhagat Singh

The author of the book 'Why I Am an Atheist' is freedom fighter Bhagat Singh. He was born on the 28th of September in the year 1907. At the age of 12 Bhagat Singh witnessed the Jallianwala Bagh massacre and took an oath to free India from the British. He was a member of the Hindustan Republican Association. After seeing Lala Lajpat Rai beaten to death, Bhagat Singh and his fellow revolutionaries vowed revenge. Bhagat Singh, Sukhdev and Rajguru blamed John B.Saunders for Lala's death but mistakenly killed James A. Scott. The three revolutionaries were hanged on March 23, 1931. Their death shook the entire country and left a deep void in people's hearts. His sacrifice and resilience continue to inspire people of all ages. His legacy reminds the youth to stand up against wrongdoing and fight for justice His 116th birthday is being celebrated across the country.

#### 3) ANS a) Bishwanath Ghat

Ministry of Tourism has declared Biswanath Ghat in Assam as the Best Tourism Village of India for the year 2023. Biswanath Ghat, situated to the south of Biswanath Chariali Town, is famously referred to as 'Gupta Kashi.' This name is derived from the ancient Biswanath temple in the town and draws a parallel with Kashi during the illustrious Gupta Empire.

#### 4) ANS a) Vettaikaranputhur

Vettaikaranputhur in Coimbatore district was awarded the bronze medal by the central government as the best tourist village in Tamil Nadu and Hullada village in Nilgiris district also won the bronze medal.

#### 5) ANS **b) 2008**

According to the Biodiversity act 2002, Tamilnadu Biodiversity Board was set up on 2008 in chennai. The State government recently reconstituted the Tamil Nadu State Biodiversity Board and the Minister for Forests will be the chairperson of the board. Function of the Tamilandu Biodiversity Board is to advise the State Government, subject to any guidelines issued by the Central Government, on matters relating to the conservation of biodiversity, sustainable use of its components and equitable sharing of the benefits arising out of the utilization of biological resources.

### 6)ANS **b) 8.6%**

According to the 2011 census, the percentage of elderly population is 8.6%. The United Nations Population Fund has reported that by 2050, the elderly population of India will double and by 2046 will surpass the children population. Currently with 65 per cent of Indians under the age of 35 has the largest population of adolescents and youth in the world. The young and working age population creates the hope that it will help the economy move forward. But the report says that by the middle of this century people over 60 will make up one fifth of India's population.
