Shastri was a freedom fighter and a close associate of Mahatma Gandhi. He played a key role in the Indian independence movement and was imprisoned several times by the British. He served as the second Prime Minister of India from 1964 until his untimely demise in 1966. His tenure as Prime Minister marked a period of significant change and progress for India. His tenure was marked by several notable achievements, including the signing of the Tashkent Agreement . ne of Lal Bahadur Shastri's enduring legacies is the slogan "Jai Jawan Jai Kisan".

Speed performance has increased by 3.59 times since the introduction of 5G in India, with the average download speed rising from 13.87 Mbps in September 2022 to 50.21 Mbps in August 2023. This improvement has seen India improve its international internet speed ranking. It has moved up 72 places from 119th place to 47th place. This ranking has been published by Ookla International website. The United Arab Emirates ranked first, Qatar second and Kuwait third.
