Kudankulam project



In News:

Madras HC recently dismissed 2017's PIL petition against Kudankulam Nuclear Power Project (KKNPP).

Key Points:

- A PIL was filed for not complying with norms on restricting the population growth in the sterilized zone i.e. the area within a 5-km radius of the plant.
- The Kudankulam Nuclear Power Project is a nuclear power plant complex located in Kudankulam, Tirunelveli district, Tamil Nadu.
- It is the largest nuclear power plant in India and one of the largest in Asia.
- The plant is being built in phases, with four units currently operational and six more under construction.

Did you Know?

 The Kudankulam Nuclear Power Plant is being built in collaboration with Russia.

In News:

National Tiger Conservation Authority (NTCA) will submit its report pertaining to tiger deaths in Mudumalai Tiger Reserve (MTR) circle.

Key facts

- Within a span of 40 days, death of 10 tigers were reported in Mudumalai tiger reserve circle (MTRC).
- MTRC comprises Mudumalai tiger reserve and forest divisions of Gudalur and Nilgiris.

About Mudumalai Tiger Reserve(MTR)

- Mudumalai Tiger Reserve (MTR) is a protected area located in the Nilgiris District of Tamil Nadu
- It is a part of the Nilgiri Biosphere.
- MTR shares borders with Wayanad Wildlife Sanctuary in Kerala on the west, Bandipur National Park in Karnataka on the north, and the Nilgiris North Division on the south and east.

The project is launched to promote the use of reusable cloth bags, also known as manjappai, as an alternative to plastic bags. The campaign was launched in 2021 The main purpose of the project is to eliminate the use of plastic bags and revive the age-old tradition of using manjappai in the state.
