1) ANS b)Tamil Nadu

Government of Tamilnadu has waived taxes and fines for businessmen. This scheme is named as Samathan scheme. According to this if theg tax, interest and fines are less than Rs. 50 thousand, the amount will be completely waived off. Other traders are exempted from the suit by paying a certain percentage. This is the first time in the history of Tamil Nadu that the small businessmen have been completely waived of tax arrear With this decision of the government, 95,502 traders involved in 1.40 lakh cases will benefit from dues waiver.

Bihar government has unveiled a 10% reservation quota for people falling under the Economically Weaker Section (EWS) category in the state's judicial services, as well as in government-run law college.

This theme aims to unite stakeholders and raise awareness about the cotton sector's crucial role in economic growth, agricultural development, trade, and poverty reduction.

New Delhi hosted 46th Pacific Asia Travel Association Exhibition. The Pacific Asia Travel Association (PATA) founded in 1951, with its Head Quarters in Bangkok, is a renowned not-for-profit association recognized internationally for its role as a catalyst in the responsible development of travel and tourism in the Asia Pacific region. PATA Travel Mart is one of the important international trade exhibitions catering to the tourism sector and it serves as a platform for trade interactions between global buyers and sellers mostly from the Asia Pacific region. The Mart will bring together exhibitors and attendees from diverse sectors, offering a unique platform for networking, learning and collaboration.

Chola and Vijayanagar period copper coins were found in the field survey conducted at Ulundhampat, Cuddalore district. Total 3 coins were found. 2 of the coins are inscribed as "Srirajaraja" in Devanagari script from the Chola period and the remaining one coin is inscribed as "Sreenilakanda" in Devanagari script from

the Vijayanagara period. Archaeological traces of ancient people have been found in the Then Pennai River basin from the Sangam period to the Chola period.
