1) ANS b) Operation Ajay

Government of India has launched Operation Ajay to rescue the Indian citizens from Israel amid a full-blown war with the Hamas group in Gaza. There are 18,000 Indians in Israel.

Operation Blue Star - operation of the Indian Army on 6th June, 1984. The operation was aimed at capturing Sikh separatists who had taken refuge in the Golden Fort of Amritsar.

Operation Shakti - Five nuclear test explosions conducted by India at the Pokhran Test Site on 11 May and 13 May 1998.

Operation Polo - Military operation carried out by the Indian Armed Forces against the state of Hyderabad in September 1948.

3) ANS **b) 1999**

Jayaprakash Narayan popularly called as "Lok Nayak ("People's leader"). Jay Prakash Narayan was one of the freedom fighter of the Indian national movement and was one of the leaders of the Quit India Movement in 1942. During 1970's JP Narayan emerged as a leading figure in the movement against the policies of Prime Minister Indira Gandhi. He was awarded the Ramon Magsaysay Award in 1965 and Bharat Ratna in 1999 .Government of India celebrated 120th birthday anniversary of Jayaprakash Narayan on 11th october.

4) ANS b) 6.3%

The International Monetary Fund raised India's GDP projection marginally by 0.2% from July's estimates of 6.1% to 6.3% even as it slashed the global growth forecast to 3% for Financial year 2024.

5) ANS c) October 10

World Mental Health Day on October 10th is a global initiative that brings organizations and individuals together to commemorate the importance of mental well-being. World Mental Health Day was established by the World Federation for Mental Health (WFMH) in 1992. World Mental Health Day 2023 provides a platform for individuals and communities to unite under the theme "Mental health is a universal human right." The theme of World Mental Health Day 2023 serves as a catalyst for individuals and communities to address mental health challenges.

6)ANS **b) 44,366 crore rupees**

Government of Tamilnadu had provided Rs 44,366 crore for the capital expenditure in the budget estimates for 2023-24 and spend 22.44% of the budgeted amount till August. Government of Tamilnadu attempt to manage the revenue deficit of Rs 37,540 crore in 2023-24.

7)ANS c) Chennai

Government of Tamilnadu will organise a International 'KaniTamil 24' conference in February 2024 in chennai. Aim of the conference is exploring the possiblities of using Tamil in natural language processing and artificial intelligence etc.

8)ANS b) Kerala

Kerala was declared a fully literate state on 18 April 1991 as per UNESCO norms. However, as per the 2011 census, about 18 lakh people were illiterate. To achieve 100 percent literacy, the state of Kerala came up with a scheme called "Aksara Laxam". This scheme was launched on 26th January 2018. It aims to eradicate illiteracy among people like tribals, fishermen and slum dwellers and The objective is to achieve 100 percent literacy and make it a state with no literacy in the country.

9)ANS b) Mayiladuthurai

Tamilnadu Legislative assembly adopted the bill to make Mayiladuthurai district as a protected agricultural zone. Declaring as Protected Special Agriculture Zone ensures that the region will not be granted permission for any new projects related to hydrocarbons. Only Agro based Industries would be given permission to be built. Under Tamilnadu protected Agricultural zone development act 2020, Government announced Thanjavur, Tiruvarur, Nagappattinam and few blocks of Pudukottai and Cuddalore as Protected Agricultural zone.

10) ANS d) October 12

World Sight Day observed annually on the second Thursday of October is a global event meant to draw attention to blindness and vision impairment. This year it falls on 12th October. "LOVE YOUR EYES AT WORK" is the theme of this year. This World Sight Day, our focus is on helping people understand the importance of protecting their vision in the workplace and calling on business leaders to priorities the eye health of workers, everywhere.
