Context:

Government of Tamilnadu launched **Project Nilgri Tahr** at **25** crore.

Nilgri Tahr:

- The Nilgiri Tahr is the state animal of Tamil Nadu. It inhabits the southern part of the Nilgiri Hills and the Western and Eastern Ghats in the states of Kerala.
- The species is classified as **"endangered"** by the International Union for Conservation of Nature.

Nilgri Tahr Day:

- October 7 celebrated as 'Nilgiri Tahr Day' in honour of E.R.C. Davidar.
- He was responsible for pioneering one of the first studies on Nilgiri Tahr in 1975.

Periodic Labour Force Survey Report:

- National Sample Survey Office (NSSO) launched Periodic Labour Force Survey (PLFS) in April 2017.
- The objective of PLFS is to estimate the key employment and unemployment indicators (viz. Worker Population Ratio, Labour Force Participation Rate, Unemployment Rate) in the short time interval of three months in both rural and urban areas annually.

Female Labour Force Participation:

Female Labour Force Participation Rate in the country has improved significantly by 4.2 percentage points to 37.0% in 2023.

UMMEED



Context

Ministry of Education has released guidelines for schools called UMMEED.

UMMEED:(Understand, Motivate, Manage, Empathise, Empower and Develop)

Key points:

- The guidelines are intended to address the growing concern among students about self-harm and suicide.
- The guidelines, based on the principle that 'every child matters', are now open for public comment and provide clear mechanisms for schools to improve the handling of self-harm cases.
- The proposed measures include the establishment of a School Wellness Team (SWT) responsible for identifying students showing warning signs and those at risk of self-harm and providing immediate response and support to their needs.

- 8. Innovations to accelerate the fight against tuberculosis.


World Students' Day

- This day is a tribute to his remarkable contributions to education and his unwavering commitment to the welfare of children and students across India and the





APJ Abdul Kalam




APJ Abdul Kalam:

- He was the 11th President of India from 2002 to 2007.
- He was born on 15th October 1931, in Rameswaram, Tamil Nadu, India.
- His full name was Avul Pakir Jainulabdeen Abdul Kalam.
- APJ Abdul Kalam played a significant role in the development of India's missile program.
- He was instrumental in the design and development of the Agni, Prithvi, and Akash missiles, which made India self-sufficient in missile technology.
- Kalam was also the chief architect of India's nuclear weapon program
- He played a crucial role in the Pokhran-II nuclear tests conducted in 1998.
- He wrote books such as

International Rural Women's Day


International Rural Women's Day:
