1) ANS a) Ladakh

The Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs (CCEA) has given the green light to the Green Energy Corridor (GEC) Phase-II – Inter-State Transmission System (ISTS) for a massive 13-gigawatt (GW) Renewable Energy (RE) project in Ladakh. This ambitious project is poised to reshape the renewable energy landscape in India. The project's primary objective is to establish a colossal 13 GW renewable energy project in Ladakh, a region known for its complex terrain, harsh climatic conditions, and defense sensitivities. The Ministry of New & Renewable Energy (MNRE) revealed that the project has an estimated total cost of Rs 20,773.70 crore

2) ANS a) Indira Sena Reddy Nallu

President Droupadi Murmu appointed Raghubar Das, ex-Jharkhand CM, as 26th Odisha's Governor, and Indra Sena Reddy Nallu as 20th Tripura's Governor. Raghubar Das served as the Chief Minister of Jharkhand from 2014 to 2019. He is the only leader who completed a full five-year term as the Chief Minister of Jharkhand. Indrasena Reddy is a three-time MLA and a prominent BJP leader from Telangana.

India has been ranked 64th out of 108 countries in the Global Remote Work Index (GRWI). This marks a substantial decline of 15 places from the previous year raising concerns about the country's readiness for remote work. The Global Remote Work Index developed and published by cybersecurity firm NordLayer. Denmark,Netherlands and Germany are 1st,2nd and 3rd rank respectively. They are ranked according to the following criteria

- 1. Cyber Safety
- 2. Economic Safety
- 3. Digital and Physical Infrastructure
- 4. Social Safety

5) ANS c)Rural Electrification Corporation

Rural Electrification Corporation (REC) Limited has been recognized for its exceptional performance in risk management with the esteemed Golden Peacock Award. The Golden Peacock Awards, established by the Institute of Directors (IOD), India in 1991, has emerged as an internationally acclaimed standard for Corporate Excellence. REC was set up in July 1969. Rural Electrification Corporation also recognized as maharatna status.
