Tribal welfare dept implements English language programme for 131 residential schools	<ul> <li>In News: Tribal welfare dept implements English language programme for 131 residential schools in 9 districts</li> <li>To enhance the English-speaking skills of students in Government Tribal Residential (GTR) schools, the Tribal Welfare department recently launched an English project at 131 GTRs in nine districts of Tamil Nadu.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Key Points:</li> <li>Through this initiative, as many as 6,500 students at GTRs are expected to be benefitted in Erode, Namakkal, Salem, Trichy, Perambalur, Tiruvannamalai, Kallakuruchi, Tirupatthur and Dharmapuri districts.</li> <li>The primary goal of this initiative is to revamp the ways in which the English language is learned in class.</li> <li>For this, students will be taught the subject through practical ways such as music, storytelling and mime.</li> </ul>
