Key points: • PMI is an economic indicator, which is derived after monthly surveys of different companies. • It measures activity at the purchasing or input stage. • In this sense, it is very different from industrial production which is indicative of actual production. • E.g., the Index of Industrial Production (IIP) measures output. Did you know? • There are two types of PMI — Manufacturing PMI and Services PMI. • The index shows trends in both the manufacturing and services sector. • PMI does not capture informal sector activity. • PMI data for India is released by S&P Global - a global major in financial information and analytics.

EU report calls for 2% global wealth tax on billionaires

Context

The European Union Tax Observatory in its 'Global Tax Evasion Report 2024' has called for a global minimum tax on billionaires equal to 2% of their wealth.

Key points

- This step was taken because tax evasion was enabling billionaires to enjoy effective tax rates equivalent to 0% to 0.5% of their wealth.
- This would both address evasion and "generate nearly \$250 billion from less than 3,000 individuals
- While the number of taxpayers affected by it would be miniscule, the tax rate for them (2%) "would still be very modest" given that the wealth of billionaires has grown at 7% a year

About Convention

- The Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations (1961) is a treaty that defines the framework for the conduct of diplomatic relations between countries.
- It was adopted in 1961 by the United Nations Conference on Diplomatic Intercourse and Immunities held in Vienna, Austria.
- This treaty lays down the rules and regulations of diplomatic relations between countries and also the privileges that diplomats enjoy in other countries.
- India ratified the convention through the Diplomatic Relations (Vienna Convention) Act of 1972.

State Educational Achievement Survey 2023	In News: • The State Educational Achievement Survey (SEAS) for the year 2023 is set to take place on November 3.
	 Key Points: National assessment regulator PARAKH will conduct the first State Education Achievement Survey on November 3. Officials said that this is the first such survey conducted by the Performance Assessment, Review and Analysis of Knowledge for Holistic Development (PARAKH), an organisation under the NCERT.
	 The survey is designed to improve learning standards for students in classes 3, 6, and 9. It covers subjects like Tamil, English and Mathematics, and will be conducted across all types of schools, including government, aided, private, and CBSE schools. The SEAS programme is administered by a team of key personnel including the Statelevel coordinator, state project director of Samagra Shiksha, State Council of Educational Research and Training (SCERT) director (implementation) and associate State-level coordinators. At the district level, district-level coordinators will play a crucial role, with the Chief Education Officer (CEO) responsible for monitoring and the principal of the District Institute of Education and Training (DIET) overseeing implementation.
Union govt approves Rs 19.68 crore bonus for railway employees	In News: The union government has given the green light to a Productivity Linked Bonus (PLB) of Rs 19.68 crore bonus for railway employees for the financial year 2022-23.
