1) ANS b) 2030

According to the article released by S&P Global Market Intelligence India's economy is booming set to reach \$7.3 trillion GDP by 2030 making it Asia-Pacific's second-largest economy. India to surpass Japan in 2030 to become 2nd largest economy of Asia. By 2030 India's GDP is also forecast to surpass Germany. At the end of 2022, the size of Indian GDP had already become larger than the GDP of the UK and also France. Currently India is now the third-largest economy in the Asia-Pacific region and the fifth-largest in the world.

2) ANS b) Kalol

Minstry of Home Affairs inaugurated the Nano DAP (Liquid) Plant of (IFFCO) at Kalol in Gandhinagar, Gujarat, aiming to make India self-sufficient in food production and fertilizers. Nano DAP (Liquid) is a groundbreaking product that contains 8 percent nitrogen and 16 percent phosphorus. This innovative liquid fertilizer is poised to replace the traditional 50 kg bags of DAP, currently priced at Rs 1,350 for farmers. Liquid urea to increase the population of earthworms in farmland, promoting natural farming practices without compromising production and income.

Kerala became the first state in India to have hallmarking centres in all 14 districts. The opening of hallmarking centres across the districts will make Kerala a hub of gold business and further strengthen its claim to being the most reliable market in the country to buy gold ornaments.

Infantry Day is celebrated every year to commemorate the landing of the 1st Battalion of the SIKH Regiment at Srinagar airfield on 27 Oct 1947 to protect the people of Jammu & Kashmir from the nefarious designs of Pakistani Kabaili Raiders aided by the Pakistan Army. This gallant action resulted in foiling of Pakistan's plans to occupy Jammu & Kashmir. Infantry is also known as the "Queen of the Battle" and it's history is as old as the first human war. The infantry has played a crucial role in the army in protecting the sovereignty of the nation since independence. Be it the war of 1962 with China or of 1947-48 with Pakistan, be it the war of 1965, 71 or 1999 Kargil conflict. The contribution of infantry in triumphing these historical wars is unparallel. Apart from these wars, the Counter Insurgency/ Counter Terrorist Operations in North and North East, Op BLUE STAR and Op RAKSHAK in Punjab, Op PAWAN in Sri Lanka and recently Op SNOW LEOPARD in Eastern Ladakh have been the continuous witness of the sheer professionalism and commitment of infantry which eventually led to success of these operations.
