

1) ANS d)1924 and 2017

Following the recommendation of the Acworth Committee in 1920-21 Separate Railway Budget was presented in parliament on 1924. John Matthai presented the first Railway Budget for independent India. Mamata Banerjee (later Chief Minister of West Bengal) became the first female Railway Minister presented the railway budget in 2000. The Railway Budget was merged with the Union Budget in 2017 ending a practice that began in 1924 under British rule. First combined budget was presented by Arun Jaitely in 2017.

2) ANS c) Thailand

After Srilanka offering free visas to Indian tourists, Now Thailand also offers free visas to india and taiwan tourists to revitalize its tourism industry.

3) ANS d) India

India is set to host the prestigious World Telecommunication Standardisation Assembly (WTSA) in 2024 marking a significant step towards the advancements of 5G and 6G networks. Ministry of IT made this announcement at the India Mobile Congress 2023 emphasizing the country's growing importance in the global technology landscape.













4) ANS b) Pallavaram

Chief Minister of Tamilnadu inaugurated the Capital and International Tech Park at Pallavaram in the city. Five million square feet International Technology Park has been designed to accommodate 50,000 IT expert and CM of TN said that it was imperative for the State's industrial sector to keep pace with the rapid technological advancement world over.

5) ANS d) Bangalore

Minister of Defence inaugurated the three-day 'India Manufacturing Show' in Bengaluru, Karnataka. Sixth edition of the 'India Manufacturing Show' serves as a valuable platform for exhibitors to showcase their technologies, equipment, and research and development in various sectors, including aerospace & defense engineering, automation, robotics, and drones. This event aims to bring together the best minds, technologies, and practices, while providing opportunities for business and knowledge sharing among participants.

6) ANS b) New Delhi

The sixth session of the International Solar Association (ISA) was held in New Delhi.The Assembly is the apex decision-making body of ISA, in which each Member Country is represented. This body makes decisions concerning the implementation of the ISA's Framework Agreement and coordinated actions to be taken to achieve its objective. The Assembly meets annually at the ministerial level at the ISA's seat. It assesses the aggregate effect of the programmes and other activities in terms of deployment of solar energy, performance, reliability, cost, and scale of finance. The Sixth Assembly of the ISA is deliberating on the key initiatives of ISA on three critical issues energy access, energy security, and energy transition.













7)ANS d) 29.7 crores

National Commission for Educational Research and Training (NCERT) is planning to introduce 'Electoral Literacy' content in textbooks for urban voters to become active and responsible citizens. As a significant portion of the electorate abstained from voting in the 2019 general elections the focus is on engaging the young urban voters. This is part of the various measures taken by the Election Commission to increase voter turnout in the elections. In the last 2019 general election out of a total of 91 crore voters 29.7 crore not caste their vote.

8)ANS **b)35**

A new mushroom species named Candolleomyces albosquamosus has been discovered in the Jawaharlal Nehru Tropical Botanic Garden and Research Institute (JNTBGRI) at Palode, Thiruvananthapuram. The discovery is notable because there are only 35 known species in the Candolleomyces genus worldwide.

9)ANS b) Reetika Hooda

Reetika Hooda became the first ever Indian female wrestler to become the U-23 World Champion.She defeated USA's Kennedy Blades by 9-2 in Tirana, Albania. Reetika also won bronze in the U-20 World Championship held last year.

10) ANS b) October 31

World Thrift Day is celebrated every year on October 31, across the world. World Thrift Day, also often called World Savings Day. The day is significant as it is an occasion to generate awareness about the concept of saving money in a bank (so as to enrich the money supply in the country) instead of keeping it locked away at home. This year, the theme of World Thrift Day is "Saving prepares you for the future".
