Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Anna Yojana (PMGKAY)



Context

The Union government's scheme to provide 5 kg of free food grains every month to **80 crore Indians**, which is slated to end this December, will be extended for another five years.

Key points

- The Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Anna Yojana (PMGKAY) was introduced in 2020 as a pandemic relief measure, providing 5 kg of free foodgrains per beneficiary a month in addition to the 5 kg of subsidised foodgrains they were entitled to under the National Food Security Act.
- This is now being extended to another 5 years.

De-induction of the IL-38



Context

- The de-induction of the IL-38 aircraft was done recently.
- C-295 aircraft in the medium-range maritime patrol aircraft (MPA) can take its role in the future

About IL-38

- IL-38 is a maritime reconnaissance aircraft that was commissioned into the Indian Navy in 1977 and remained a formidable air asset throughout its service life for nearly 44 years.
- It was with the induction of IL 38 aircraft that the Navy moved into the arena of airborne Long Range Maritime Reconnaissance (LRMR) combined with long range antisubmarine search and strike, anti-shipping strike, electronic signal intelligence and distant SAR.
- The IL 38 is an all-weather aircraft with long endurance and substantial operating range. Having clocked nearly 10,000 hours of operational flying.

Zika Virus

Context

Five Karnataka villages come under surveillance after Zika virus outbreak.

About Zika Virus

- It is a mosquito-borne virus that was first identified in the Zika Forest of Uganda in 1947.
- It is primarily transmitted to humans through the bite of infected Aedes mosquitoes, particularly Aedes aegypti and Aedes albopictus.
- It can also spread through sexual contact, blood transfusion, and from an infected mother to her baby during pregnancy or childbirth.
- This virus infection is usually mild, it can have serious consequences for pregnant women and their babies.
- Infection during pregnancy can lead to birth defects such as microcephaly, as well as other neurological disorders in the baby.
- It has also been linked to Guillain-Barré syndrome, a rare autoimmune disorder that can lead to muscle weakness and paralysis.
- Treatment: There is no specific treatment available for Zika virus infection or disease.

NCERT to introduce electoral literacy content in textbooks



Context

In a bid to address voter apathy among young Indians, the National Council of Educational Research and Training (NCERT) will introduce and update textbooks to include content on electoral literacy

Key points

- The measures are part of a memorandum of understanding signed the Election Commission of India (EC) and the Education Ministry.
- It is aimed at extending the EC's flagship Systematic Voters' Education and Electoral Participation (SVEEP) in schools and colleges.
- The MoU aims to address issues such as voter apathy among urban and young

Key Points:

- The State Fisheries Department said that the mouth of the Pulicat Lake gets blocked every year and fishermen are suffering as they could not venture into the sea using their boats.
- The government order was issued in October 2020 to desilt the mouth and to construct training walls for permanent stability of the bar mouth.
- The project will be implemented at Rs. 26.85 crore.
- The fisheries department will also conduct post-construction marine biological studies to understand the impact on the corals, marine organisms, turtle nesting, and others.
