#### 1) ANS d)Sri Lanka

Finance Minister of India participated in the "Naam 200 Commemoration" program held in Colombo, Sri Lanka to mark the 200th anniversary of Tamils of Indian origin who suffered historical injustices including loss of citizenship and harsh working conditions in tea plantations.

#### 2) ANS c)India

India will host the Quad Summit in 2024. The Quadrilateral Group consisting of India, Australia, Japan and the U.S. was formed in 2017. It aims to strengthen the defence and security cooperation amongst the four countries.

#### 3) ANS a)Tamil Nadu

Tamil Nadu ranked as first state in consumer empowering initiatives followed by Kerala and Madhya Pradesh. The Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI) released the State Food Safety Index (SFSI) 2022-2023, which assesses the performance of Indian states and union territories in ensuring food safety. In Food Testing Infrastructure category, Gujarat and Kerala were the top performers in this category, while Andhra Pradesh performed the worst. In Compliance category Punjab and Himachal Pradesh received the highest scores, while Jharkhand received the lowest.

#### 4) ANS a) United Nations Environment programme

The United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP) gives the champions of the earth award. It is awarded every year by UNEP to seven young environmentalists from around the world between the ages of 18 and 30, for their outstanding ideas to protect the environment. The United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP) announced the 2023 Champions of the Earth for their innovative solutions and transformative action to tackle plastic pollution.

#### 5) ANS c) Netherlands

World Local Manufacturing Forum 2023 will held in Netherlands. The World Local Production Platform is a platform created at the initiative of WHO with the aim of increasing access to medicines and other health technologies.

#### 6) ANS d) November 5

World Tsunami Awareness Day is observed on 5<sup>th</sup> November to raise awareness of the dangerous effects of tsunamis and the importance of tsunami preparedness and early warning of tsunamis. It was announced by United Nations General Assembly in 2015. World Tsunami Awareness Day's 2023 theme, "Fighting Inequality for a Resilient Future," echoes the emphasis on reducing inequality during the International Day for Disaster Reduction.

#### 7)ANS a) Deenanath Rajput

Deenanath Rajput was awarded the Second Rohini Nayyar Prize for his for his work on empowering tribal women in Bastar, Chhattisgarh. The award was presented in memory of the late economist-administrator Dr. Rohini Nayyar, and it came with a trophy, a citation, and a cash prize of Rs 10 lakh. First Rohini Nayyar Prize was received by Sethrichem Sangtam.











### 8)ANS b) 9.4

India witnessed 53 accidents and 19 deaths every hour, or an average of 1,264 accidents and 42 deaths, daily in road crashes last year, according to a Ministry of Road Transport and Highways report. The number of road accidents in 2022 increased by 11.9% and deaths rose by 9.4%. According to World Road Statistics, 2022 published by the International Road Federation, Geneva, which uses data for the year 2020 in terms of the total number of fatalities, India was followed by China and the U.S Uttar Pradesh registered the highest share of deaths at 13.4%. This was followed by Tamil Nadu at 10.6% and Maharashtra at 9%.

#### 9)ANS a) Germany

2023 Sultan of Johor Cup is an international men's under-21 field hockey tournament conducted in Malaysia. Totally 8 teams participitated. Germany won Sultan of Johor Cup by defeating Australia. India won bronze medal by defeating Pakistan.

### 10) ANS c) November 3

People observed the International Day for Biosphere Reserves on November 3 which is established by UNESCO during its 41st General Conference in 2022. Biosphere Reserves play a crucial role in the conservation of our planet's natural and cultural diversity. Currently there are 738 biosphere reserves in 134 countries. India has 18 Biosphere reserve.
