Deepwater ports	 Context: Tamil Nadu Maritime Board has identified 17 sites for development as direct berthing and deepwater ports.
	 ports. Key Points: It was decided after taking into account the availability of draft, general marine conditions, minimum burden on existing infrastructure, proximity to hinterland cargo and promotion of regional development, according to Tamil Nadu State Ports Development Policy. The 17 locations include Cuddalore, Nagapattinam, Rameswaram, Pamban, Kanyakumari, Colachel, Kattupuli, Ennore minor port, Panaiyur, PY-03 Oil Field, Thiruchopuram, Silambimangalam, Parangipettai, Thirukaddaiyur, Thirkkuvalai, Udangudi and Kudankulam. Government agencies can invest up to 11% of equity in the port company. Private initiatives for developing deepwater ports will be allowed, with a long-term lease period of 30 years. After 10 years, the board will review performance, and upon the operator's request, the lease can be extended to 99 years. Tamil Nadu State Ports Development Policy,2023 The Tamil Nadu State Ports Development Policy, 2023 aims to attract investments for port-based development. The policy includes: Encouraging ship building Utilizing port infrastructure Promoting green harbors Developing about 17 small ports across the state Awarding ports directly to companies entering into joint venture with government agencies Tamil Nadu has three major ports, in Chennai, Ennore and Tuticorin. There is also an intermediate port in between these major ports at Nagapattinam.

TN fertility rate	 Context: Tamil Nadu fertility rate has declined to 1.4 percent from 2.1 percent, and the state population is under control. Key points: India's fertility rate in 2023 is 2.139 births per woman. This is a 0.93% decline from 2022. India's birth rate in 2023 is 16.949 births per 1,000 people, which is a 1.25% decline from 2022. Five states in India are above the replacement level of fertility of 2.1. These states are: Bihar, Meghalaya, Uttar Pradesh, Jharkhand, Manipur.
	 Fertility Rate: Fertility rate is the average number of children born to women during their reproductive years. It is calculated by dividing the total number of live births in a population by the number of females aged 15-44. The ratio is then multiplied by 1,000.
2.5L trees planted so far in TN's Ramanathapuram	 Context: 2.5L trees planted so far in TN's Ramanathapuram to improve green cover In order to increase the district's green cover and bioshield in coastal regions, the forest department has planted more than 2.5 lakh trees under the Green Tamil Nadu Mission in the past two weeks.

However, owing to issues, the percentage of green cover in Ramanathapuram is at 6.25%. As a result, several measures including planting lakhs of trees are being undertaken. The forest department plans to plant more than 5.5 lakh tree saplings for the year 2023-24.
