Indo Pacific Regional Dialogue held in New Delhi. The theme of IPRD-2023 is "Geopolitical Impacts upon Indo-Pacific Maritime Trade and Connectivity".

3) ANS a) Bihar

The Bihar Assembly unanimously passed a Bill to increase reservation for Backward Classes, Extremely Backward Classes, Scheduled Castes, and Scheduled Tribes from the existing 50% to 65%. Bills providing for the same increase in reservation in educational institutions and government jobs, which were drafted based on the recent caste survey in the State, too were passed unanimously through voice vote in the State Assembly.

Australia Won the ICC Cricket World Cup 2023 by 6 Wickets. Australia won the One-day World cup sixth time. They are 1987, 1999, 2003, 2007, 2015 and 2023.

6) ANS b)Maldives

Cyclone Mithili formed over the Bay of Bengal and made landfall near Khepupara, Bangladesh. It brought heavy rain and strong winds to the coastal areas of Odisha, West Bengal, and Bangladesh. The deep depression would move northnortheastwards and further intensify into a cyclone, the IMD predicted. The cyclone would be named 'Midhili' once it forms, a name contributed by the Maldives.Cyclone Midhili will be the second cyclone of the season in the Bay of Bengal after cyclone Hamoon in late October.

7)ANS b) India and Sri Lanka

The ninth edition of Joint Military exercise "Exercise MITRA SHAKTI-2023" commenced today in Aundh (Pune). The aim of the exercise is to jointly rehearse conduct of Sub Conventional operations under Chapter VII of United Nations Charter. Exercise MITRA SHAKTI – 2023 will also involve employment of Drones and Counter Unmanned Aerial Systems besides helicopters. Drills to secure helipads and undertake casualty evacuation during counter-terrorist operations will also be rehearsed jointly by both sides.













8)ANS b)Tamil Nadu

Minister for Handlooms and Textiles R Gandhi said mini textile parks would be established in all districts across the state. These mini textile parks are developed at a cost of Rs 2.5 crore and will have facilities to accommodate three textile units. Also, synthetic fiber manufacturers will be promoted by the state government under the new textile policy.
