Nasha Mukt Bharat Abhiyaan Program launched by Department of Social Justice and Empowerment. Nasha Mukt Bharat Abhiyaan is operational with the involvement of more than 500 voluntary organizations across the country, which are assisted financially under the National Action Plan for Drug Demand Reduction (NAPDDR) scheme of the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment.

These NGOs have been actively involved in the implementation of Drug-Free India campaign. Nearly 8000 youth volunteers and outreach workers of these institutions/organizations have gone from door to door, village to village and nearby localities, etc. to educate the people about the ill effects of drug abuse and have assisted in the rehabilitation of victims of substance abuse.

2) ANS a) National Institute of Educational Research and Training

Performance Assessment, Review, and Analysis of Knowledge for Holistic Development(PARAKH) was initiated by National Institute of Educational Research and Training. PARAKH has been launched as a part of the implementation of the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020. It has envisaged a standard-setting body to advise school boards regarding the new assessment patterns and the latest research and promote collaboration between them. PARAKH will closely work with the state directorates of education, state, education boards, and international organizations, working in the area of assessment and evaluation. PARAKH will be responsible for conducting large-scale assessments, including the National Achievement Survey (NAS).
