National Disaster Response Force is a specialized force in India responsible for handling and managing various types of disasters, both natural and man-made. Established in 2006, the NDRF operates under the Ministry of Home Affairs and plays a crucial role in disaster response, relief, rescue, and recovery operations across the country. Comprising highly trained personnel and equipped with modern equipment, the NDRF has emerged as a key organization in disaster management, contributing to the safety and well-being of the nation and its citizens.

Recently, National Disaster Response Force and Indian Army successfully rescued 41 workers trapped in 17 Days from the collapsed Silkyara-Barkot tunnel in Uttarakhand, India.

2) ANS c) Angkor Wat

Angkor Wat, located in Cambodia announced as 8th wonder of the world. Angorwat is temple is served as the largest religious monument in the world. Originally constructed in the 12th century by King Suryavarman II, the temple was dedicated to the Hindu deity Vishnu. Over time, it transformed into a major Buddhist temple, reflecting the transition from Hinduism to Buddhism.

3) ANS c) Ministry of Education

The Kashi Tamil Sangamam is a month-long event organized by the Ministry of Education, Government of India in 2022 to trace the age-old links between Tamil Nadu and Varanasi. The second edition of this Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat programme is proposed to be held from December 17th to 30th December 2023. Kashi Tamil Sangamam is proposed that around 1400 people from Tamil Nadu and Puducherry will travel by train to Varanasi, Prayagraj and Ayodhya for an 8 day immersive tour, including the travel time. They will be divided into 7 groups of around 200 each, comprising students, teachers, farmers & artisans, traders& businessmen, religious, writers, professionals. Each group will be named after a sacred river (Ganga, Yamuna, Saraswati, Sindhu, Narmada, Godavari and Kaveri).
