#### 1) ANS b) 10.45 crores

Based on the 2011 Census the Tribal Population is 10.45 crores constituting about 8.6% of the total population of the nation. Prime minister of India approved new scheme for tribes called as Pradhan Mantri Janjati Adivasi Nyaya Maha Abhiyan(PM JANMAN). Objective of this scheme is saturate PVTG households and habitations with basic facilities such as safe housing, clean drinking water and sanitation, improved access to education, health and nutrition, road and telecom connectivity, and sustainable livelihood opportunities.

#### 2) ANS b) Ministry of Housing and Urban Poverty Alleviation

Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs is making raw data from Indian cities available on a single platform for academics, researchers, and stakeholders to help data-driven policymaking. The Amplifi 2.0 (Assessment and Monitoring Platform for Liveable, Inclusive and Future-ready urban India) portal was launched by Ministry of Housing and Urban Poverty Alleviation .All 3,739 municipal corporations will eventually be made available on the portal. The website provides data on a range of information for several cities, including total consumption; number of samples tested for water quality; average annual expenditure on healthcare; number of slum dwellers; and road accident fatalities.

#### 3) ANS c) Saharanpur

Government of Uttarpradesh has given approval for the establishment of the country's inaugural Telecom Center of Excellence in Saharanpur. The objective is to develop and promote cutting-edge technology in the telecom sector.

Functioning as a hub for research and development, the center aims to assist experts from diverse fields and provide solutions through advanced technology.

### 4) ANS b) Squash

Velavan Senthilkumar (Tamil Nadu) and Anahat Singh (Delhi) won their maiden men's and women's National titles at the 79th National squash championships. The 15-year-old Anahat is the second youngest ever to clinch the women's crown, only behind Joshna Chinappa who won her first title in 2000 as a 14-year-old.

### 5) ANS c) Kurumbas

The Kurumba tribe is one of the oldest indigenous communities in Tamil Nadu. They are believed to have descended from the ancient Pallavas. The Kurumba people are primarily found in the Nilgiri Hills. They are traditionally hunter-gatherers. They speak their own language, Kurumba, which is a Dravidian language. They are also skilled artisans, and they make a variety of traditional handicrafts, including baskets, mats, and pottery.

### 6) ANS d) Abdullahi Mire

Abdullahi Mire, a Somali refugee, has been named the 2023 UNHCR Nansen Refugee Award Global Laureate for his work championing the right to education for displaced children. The UNHCR Nansen Refugee Award was established in 1954 to honor the legacy of Fridtjof Nansen, a Norwegian scientist, polar explorer, diplomat, and the first High Commissioner for Refugees for the League of Nations. The award is presented annually to an individual or organization for outstanding service to refugees.

### 7) ANS c) Nepal

Nepal becomes the first South Asian nation to register same-sex marriage, recognizing and affirming the rights of the LGBTQ+ community through the formal registration of the first same-sex marriage.
