Impact of Cyclone MICHAUNG



Context:

- The Cyclonic Storm "MICHAUNG" (pronounced as MIGJAUM) occurred over Southwest & adjoining West Central Bay of Bengal.
- It has adversely hit Andhra Pradesh and TamilNadu states.

Key points:

- Cyclone Impact: Cyclone Michaung has caused several deaths in Chennai, leading to waterlogging and power outages in multiple areas.
- Emergency Funding: Chief Minister MK Stalin seeks urgent ₹5,000 crore from the Indian government for immediate relief and restoration, to be raised by DMK MPs in Parliament.
- Localized Challenges: Residents in various areas face rising water levels, lack of rescue assistance, and prolonged power outages.
- Infrastructure Impact: Roads are flooded, fallen trees obstruct some areas, and water stagnation affects thousands of residents along the Buckingham Canal, leading to property damage and safety concerns.

Scenario of Inundation of core city:

- There is continuous and simultaneous rain in the core city as well as catchment areas of waterbodies.
- As the cyclone lies close to the sea, water from the rivers is not getting an easy passage at estuary points, resulting in reverse flow.
- Only if river water manages to flow into the sea via estuaries, will water drain via storm water drains.

5 copper plate charters found at Kutralanathar Temple



Context:

- Five ancient copper plates were found in Arulmigu Kutralanathar Swamy Temple, located in Courtallam of Tenkasi district.
- This rare discovery of these five copper plate charters belongs to the period of Azhagan Perumal Parakrama Pandyan of the Pandya Kingdom




- The Vaduvoor Bird Sanctuary has started witnessing arrival of the avians from Russia, Siberia, Myanmar, China, Malaysia and the Arctic region
- The season is at its peak in the sanctuary for migratory birds as well as local species for its availability of feeding is in abundance.

About:

- Vaduvoor Bird Sanctuary is composed of small man-made reservoirs interconnected by an ancient network of canals and fed by the sub canals in Tiruvarur recharged through the Mettur reservoir.
- The place provides habitat for around 158 bird species, including spot-billed pelican, black-headed ibis, Eurasian wigeon and northern pintail.

Vedaranyam sees surge in winged visitors



Context:

- The torrential rains battering the State particularly in the Delta region has witnessed a surge of winged visitors at Point Calimere bird sanctuary in Vedaranyam.
- About twenty to thirty thousand migratory birds were said to have flocked the Point Calimere bird sanctuary in the past few days owing to the rain factor which induces the availability of worms, insects, and saline microorganism preyed by the water birds in swampy lands.

Cauvery, Pennar in TN Vulnerable to alien fish species

Context:

- A recent study has warned that the Cauvery and Pennar River basins in Tamil Nadu are vulnerable to Invasive Alien Fish species (IAF)
- It is due to the changing climate as well as the interlinking of rivers
- The vulnerability of invasion by IAF has been identified in:
 - Cauvery River basin Karnataka and Tamil
 Nadu
 - 2. **Pennar River basin** Andhra Pradesh and Tamil Nadu
 - 3. **Krishna River basin** Karnataka and Telangana.
