This act was a combination of 11 acts regarding excise duties, and it was passed to make changes in the law related to salt and central duties. 				
	 About: On 24 February 1944, the Central Excise and Salt Act was passed, and Central Excise Day is celebrated to commemorate this legislation. In 1966, the act was renamed The Central Excise Act 1944, and Schedules 1 and 2 of the act were related to the values and rates of the duties

13th century stone inscription found at Maruthur anicut in TN



Context:

 An archaeology student has unearthed a stone inscription dating back to the 13th century, offering valuable insights into the Pandyan dynasty's rule.

Key Findings:

Belongs to King Kulasekarapandian's reign (1190-1216):

• The inscription reveals details about the construction of a temple on the banks of the Thamirabarani River by this Pandyan king.

Mentions a "mandapam":

- This structure, likely a pillared hall, suggests the temple's grandeur and potential use for religious ceremonies.
- Possible connection to anicut:
- Experts speculate the inscription's stones might have been repurposed for the anicut's construction, hinting at a later destruction of the mandapam, possibly during the Chola conflicts or floods.
