TN Forest dept to radio-collar 20 Nilgiri tahrs	 Context: The TN forest department has been granted permission to radio-collar 20 Nilgiri tahrs, the state animal. This initiative aims to study the cause of enlarged lymph nodes observed in some tahrs and gain insights into their movement patterns and habitat utilization. This project is part of the larger Nilgiri Tahr Conservation Project launched by theTN govt in 2023. The project aims to protect this endangered species, with an estimated population of only 3,122 individuals across Tamil Nadu and Kerala. About: Nilgiri Tahr is an endemic species of the Western Ghats It is listed as Endangered in the IUCN Red List of Threatened Species It is protected under Schedule I of the Wildlife (Protection) Act of India, 1972.


