Core loading of India's 1st indigenous nuclear reactor in Kalpakkam achieved	 Context: India achieved a significant milestone in its nuclear program with the commencement of core loading at the nation's first indigenous Prototype Fast Breeder Reactor (PFBR) in Kalpakkam, Tamil Nadu. PM Modi himself witnessed this historic event. About: This core loading marks the beginning of the second stage of India's three-stage nuclear power program. It focuses on a closed fuel cycle for efficient uranium utilization. The 500 MWe PFBR, developed by Bharatiya Nabhikiya Vidyut Nigam Limited (BHAVINI), signifies India's progress in domestic nuclear reactor technology.

24,000 birds sighted during Thamirabarani Waterbird Count	 Nilgiri Tahr is present only in Tamil Nadu and Kerala. Context: The recent Thamirabarani Waterbird Count held between February 16th and 18th, 2024, documented an impressive 24,207 birds across 66 species. This event highlights the rich biodiversity of the Thamirabarani river basin in Tamil Nadu

	 The count was organized by ATREE's Agasthyamalai Community Conservation Centre (ACCC) along with other local groups A diverse range of birds were recorded including resident species like egrets and migratory ducks like the Northern Pintail and Bar-headed Goose. Notably, the resident Egret family dominated the count with nearly 4,861 individuals spotted.
TN achieves 98 percent pulse polio coverage	 Context: TN has achieved nearly 98% of its targeted pulse polio immunization coverage on March 4, 2024. This translates to 56.34 lakh children vaccinated against a target of 57.84 lakh children under five years old. The remaining 2% of targeted children will be reached through door-to-door campaigns in the coming week. The success is attributed to setting up over 43,000 booths across various locations and continuous efforts by the health department. About: India's Pulse Polio programme, a key part of the country's successful fight against polio, was launched in 1995, Targets: Children under 5 years old receive polio drops during National Immunization Days (NIDs)
Tangedco to import 6.5L MT coal from Malaysia to tackle summer	 twice a year and Sub-National Immunization Days (SNIDs) in high-risk areas. Context: Tangedco, Tamil Nadu's power distribution company, plans to import 6.5 lakh metric tonnes (MT) of coal from Malaysia in March and April 2024 to meet the expected rise in demand during the summer months. This comes after the central government allowed a 6% coal import quota for all distribution companies.
World Obesity Day	 Context: World Obesity Day, held annually on March 4th, is a unified day of action to raise awareness and encourage solutions to address the global obesity crisis. About: The inaugural World Obesity Day was held on March 4th, 2015. It was established by the World Obesity Federation
