Citizenship Amendment Act will not be implemented in TN	<ul> <li>Context:         <ul> <li>TN CM announced that the Citizenship (Amendment) Act (CAA), rules for which were notified on Monday, March 11 by the Union Home Ministry, would not be implemented in Tamil Nadu.</li> <li>He said that the CAA is against minorities and Sri Lankan Tamils living in camps in the State</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>About:</li> <li>The Citizenship (Amendment) Act, 2019 was passed by the Parliament of India on 11 December 2019.</li> <li>It amended the Citizenship Act, 1955 by providing an accelerated pathway to Indian citizenship for persecuted religious minorities from Afghanistan, Bangladesh and Pakistan who arrived in India by 2014.</li> </ul>
TN announces 4% hike in DA for govt. employees, pensioners	<ul> <li>Context: <ul> <li>The Tamil Nadu government has announced a 4% increase in Dearness Allowance (DA) for state government employees, teachers, and pensioners.</li> <li>This hike is effective from January 1, 2024, and benefits around 16 lakh employees.</li> <li>The increase is expected to cost the state exchequer an additional Rs 2,587.91 crore annually.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
Strengthening soil organic carbon levels	<ul> <li>Context: <ul> <li>An expert warns that strengthening soil organic carbon levels is essential for Tamil Nadu (T.N.) to achieve its carbon sequestration targets.</li> <li>Studies show low carbon content in T.N. forests, hindering healthy plant growth.</li> <li>Maintaining healthy soil is vital for achieving T.N.'s carbon sequestration goals.</li> <li>Conserving soil organic carbon is crucial as it can be lost through:</li> <li>Tilling and exposing soil</li> <li>Forest fires</li> <li>Reduced biodiversity</li> <li>Intense rainfall causing erosion</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
