Kerala, Karnataka, and Tamil Nadu Unite to Mitigate Human-Animal Conflict	 Forest departments of Kerala, Karnataka, and Tamil Nadu collaborate to prevent human-animal conflict in Nilgiri Biosphere Reserve. Meeting held at Theppakadu training centre in Mudumalai Tiger Reserve to discuss strategies. Participants include field directors of Bandipur Tiger Reserve, Nagarkole National Park, and Wayanad Wildlife Sanctuary, along with respective deputy directors and district forest officers (DFOs). Meeting prompted by an incident of elephant killing a man in Wayanad, allegedly due to lack of information sharing between Karnataka and Kerala forest departments. Decision made to hold meetings every three months as per NTCA guidelines. Focus on timely communication and cooperation to address cross-border movement of problematic animals. Emphasis on coordinated efforts to manage wildlife in the Nilgiri Biosphere Reserve landscape.
Chennai Set to Emerge as Global Hub for Renault-Nissan Automotive Manufacturing	 Context: Chennai poised to become a pivotal global asset for Renault-Nissan Alliance with the launch of four new SUVs from the Oragadam plant. Emphasis on localisation and advancement in technologies like autonomous driving, connectivity, and electrification for global markets. President and CEO of Nissan Motor, Makoto Uchida, announces plans for unveiling five-seater and seven-seater SUVs, heavily localised for production. Oragadam plant, under 'Make in India' initiative, currently manufactures 90% of car components locally. Over 2.7 million cars were produced at the plant, with 1.2 million exported to over 100 destinations.

	 Oragadam plant in Chennai operates at capacity to produce 480 cars per day, currently producing 178 cars daily. Focus on reducing carbon footprint, water usage, and increasing renewable energy utilisation, according to Renault-Nissan Alliance chairman, Jean-Dominique Senard.
Technical Issue Affects Two Thermal Units in Tamil Nadu, Resulting in 810MW Output Reduction	 Power generation halted at Tangedco's 600 MW Mettur thermal plant and 210 MW North Chennai stage 1 unit due to technical issues. Estimated time for fixing the 600 MW unit is 48 hours, while the 210 MW unit is expected to resume operation within 18 hours. Other thermal units in North Chennai, Mettur, and Thoothukudi continue power generation. State records highest power demand of 19,409 MW on March 22, with demand expected to rise due to increasing temperatures. Issues in both plants attributed to boiler tube damage and minor glitches. Power demand for agriculture decreases by 1,000 MW, aiding demand management efforts. Tamil Nadu procures 54% of its total power from private entities, with plans to acquire an additional 3,000 MW in the near future. Concerns raised over impact on Tangedco, consumers, and state government due to utility's significant debt of Rs 1.4 lakh crore, expressed by E Natarajan of Bharathiya Electricity Engineers Association.
State has over 6.23cr voters	Context:
	 Chief Electoral Officer Satyabrata Sahoo reports 6,23,26,901 voters in Tamil Nadu, comprising 3.06 crore male, 3.17 crore female, and 8,465 third gender voters. Over 10.9 lakh first-time voters and 4,61,730 persons with disabilities registered as of March 26. A total of 68,144 polling stations were established across 39 constituencies, with permission sought for 177 additional auxiliary polling stations. Seizures amounting to 69.7 crore made, including cash worth 33.31 crore, and 6.1 crore seized by the income tax department.
