### SSC CHSL 2024 Notification Eligibility Criteria

The candidates must satisfy and fulfill the eligibility criteria mentioned by the commission in the SSC CHSL 2024 notification PDF. Age and educational qualification are important aspects for satisfying eligibility conditions. We are discussing all the important eligibility criteria to be fulfilled by the candidates to register for SSC CHSL 2024.

### SSC CHSL 2024 Nationality or Citizenship

The candidates need to fulfill the following to fit into the SSC CHSL 2024 Application Criteria:

- a citizen of India, or
- a subject of Nepal, or
- a subject of Bhutan, or
- a person of Indian origin who has migrated from Pakistan, Burma, Sri Lanka, East African countries of Kenya, Uganda, the United Republic of Tanzania (Formerly Tanganyika and Zanzibar), Zambia, Malawi, Zaire, Ethiopia, and Vietnam intending to settle in India permanently.

### SSC CHSL 2024 Age Limit [As on 01 August 2024]

The candidate's minimum age should be 18 years and the maximum age must be 27 years. Candidates who wish to apply must fall



between this age limit to be eligible to apply for SSC CHSL recruitment 2024. The age limit mentioned in the official notification is as follows:

### **SSC CHSL 2024 Educational Qualification [As on 01 August 2024]**

The educational qualification required to apply for LDC/ JSA, and DEO/ DEO Grade 'A' posts is that the candidates must have passed the 12th Standard or equivalent examination from a recognized Board or University.

<b>Post</b>	<b>Educational Qualification</b>
DEO/ DEO Grade 'A' (C&AG, Ministry of Consumer Affairs, Food and Public Distribution and Ministry of Culture)	12th Standard pass in Science stream with Mathematics as a subject from a recognized Board or equivalent.
LDC/ JSA and DEO/ DEO Grade 'A' (for ministries other than those mentioned above)	12th Standard or equivalent examination passed from a recognized Board or University.

### **SSC CHSL 2024 Notification: Application Fees**

Candidates need to pay the required application fees to complete the application process. This fee is accepted via BHIM UPI, Net Banking or by using Visa, MasterCard, Maestro, RuPay Credit or Debit cards or in cash at SBI Branches by generating SBI Challan. The category-wise fee details are mentioned here.

- The application fee to be paid while applying for SSC CHSL is Rs. 100/-
- No fee is required to be paid by females, SC, ST, Physically Handicapped, and Ex-Servicemen candidates as they are exempted from paying the fee.
- Application fees can be paid through offline or online methods.

### **SSC CHSL Notification 2024: Selection Process**

Staff Selection Commission has earlier changed the SSC CHSL selection process from 3 stages to 2 stages only. The candidates applying for the recruitment process must go through the change in the new selection process as well as the exam pattern mentioned below. The SSC CHSL 2024 Selection process will be based on the following. The computer-based examination will be conducted in two tiers as follows:

**Stage 1:** Tier 1 CBT Examination

**Stage 2:** Tier 2 (CBT Examination+ Skill/Typing Test)

### **SSC CHSL Exam Pattern 2024**

**SSC will conduct two tiers, computer-based examination for the selection of candidates for SSC CHSL 2024.** The candidates qualifying the Tier I and Tier II will be eligible for final selection.

### **SSC CHSL 2024 Notification: Tier 1 Exam Pattern**

SSC CHSL 2024 Tier 1 exam contains 100 questions to be attempted in 60 minutes which will add up to a total of 200 marks. The subjects along with the distribution of questions have been shown in the table given below:

- The exam will be based on Multiple Choice Questions.
- 2 marks will be awarded for each right answer.
- There will be a negative marking of 0.50 for each wrong answer in all sections.

- Marks scored by candidates in Tier-I will be normalized.
- No sectional cut-offs will be there.
- The exam duration is 80 minutes for candidates who are visually handicapped.

### SSC CHSL Tier 2 Revised Exam Pattern

The candidates who clear the cut-off of the SSC CHSL Tier 1 exam will be called for the SSC CHSL Tier 2 exam. The exam pattern for the Tier 2 exam includes two sessions, further divided into three sections. Check out the SSC CHSL Tier 2 exam pattern 2024 in the below table:

### SSC CHSL 2024 Skill Test for Data Entry Operators

The skill test or computer proficiency test will be conducted to check the typing skills of the candidates and whether they are eligible to work on computers. Some points focusing on the SSC CHSL 2024 Skill test are as follows:

- The medium of the Typing Test will be Hindi and English.

- No candidate is exempted from appearing in the Skill Test as it is mandatory.
- This stage is qualifying in nature i.e. marks will not be added to the final merit.
- English medium Typing speed should be > 35 words per minute (w.p.m.)
- Hindi medium Typing speed should be > 30 words per minute (w.p.m.)
- Skill Test for Data Entry Operator (DEO) post will be conducted where data entry speed will be tested.

### Important Points For SSC CHSL 2024 Exam Pattern

- Candidates will be shortlisted for the Tier-II Examination based on their performance in the Tier-I Examination. Normalized scores of the candidates will be used to determine merit and for final selection.
- There will be separate category-wise cut-offs in Tier-I and subsequent Tiers for different posts i.e. (i) DEO, (ii) DEO Grade 'A', and (iii) LDC/ JSA
- Skill Test in Tier-III for DEOs is mandatory for all qualified candidates.
- Typing Test in Tier-III for posts other than DEOs is mandatory for all candidates except those who are exempted from appearing in the Typing Test.
- Final selection and allocation of Ministries/ Departments/ Offices to the candidates qualified in Tier-III will be made based on the performance of candidates in the Tier-I+Tier-II Examinations and the preference of Posts/ Departments exercised by them at the time of Document Verification.
- Candidates will be shortlisted and recommended for appointment by the Commission based on their total marks in Papers I & II and their preference for the posts.

### SSC CHSL Tier 2 Syllabus 2024

Here we have covered below the section-wise syllabus for the SSC CHSL Tier 2 exam 2024.

#### SSC CHSL Syllabus 2024: Mathematical Abilities

**Number Systems:** Computation of Whole Numbers, Decimals and Fractions, and Relationship between Numbers.

**Fundamental arithmetical operations:** Percentages, Ratio and Proportion, Square roots, Averages, Interest (Simple and Compound), Profit and Loss, Discount, Partnership Business, Time and distance, Time and Work.

**Algebra:** Basic algebraic identities of School Algebra and Elementary surds (simple problems) and Graphs of Linear Equations.

**Geometry:** Familiarity with elementary geometric figures and facts. Triangle and its various kinds of centers, Congruence and similarity of triangles, Circle and its chords, tangents, angles subtended by chords of a circle, and common tangents to two or more circles.



**Mensuration:** Triangle, Quadrilaterals, Regular Polygons, Circle, Right Prism, Right Circular Cone, Right Circular Cylinder, Sphere, Hemispheres, Rectangular Parallelepiped, Regular Right Pyramid with triangular or square Base.

**Trigonometry:** Trigonometry, Trigonometric ratios, Complementary angles, Height and distances (simple problems only) Standard Identities like  $\sin^2\theta + \cos^2\theta = 1$ , etc.

**Statistics and probability:** Use of Tables and Graphs: Histogram, Frequency polygon, Bar-diagram, Pie-chart; Measures of central tendency: mean, median, mode, standard deviation, calculation of simple probabilities

### **SSC CHSL Syllabus 2024 (General Intelligence & Reasoning)**

Questions of both verbal and non-verbal types. These will include questions on Semantic Analogy, Symbolic operations, Symbolic/ Number Analogy, Trends, Figural Analogy, Space Orientation, Semantic Classification, Venn Diagrams, Symbolic/ Number Classification, Drawing inferences, Figural Classification, Punched hole/ pattern-folding & unfolding, Semantic Series, Figural Pattern-folding and completion, Number Series, Embedded figures, Figural Series, Critical Thinking, Problem Solving, Emotional Intelligence, Word Building, Social Intelligence, Coding and de-coding, Numerical operations.

### **SSC CHSL Syllabus 2024 for English Language & Comprehension**

Vocabulary, grammar, sentence structure, synonyms, antonyms, and their correct usage; Spot the Error, Fill in the Blanks, Synonyms/ Homonyms, Antonyms, Spellings/ Detecting misspelled words, Idioms & Phrases, word substitution, Improvement of Sentences, Active/ Passive Voice of Verbs, Conversion into Direct/ Indirect narration, Shuffling of Sentence parts, Shuffling of Sentences in a passage, Cloze Passage, Comprehension Passage. To test comprehension, two or more paragraphs will be given and questions based on those will be asked. At least one paragraph should be a simple one based on a book or a story and the other paragraph should be based on current affairs editorial or a report.

### **SSC CHSL Syllabus 2024 for General Awareness**

Questions are designed to test the candidates' general awareness of the environment around them and its application to society. Questions are also designed to test knowledge of current events and such matters of everyday observation and experience in their scientific aspect as may be expected of an educated person. The test will also include questions relating to India and its neighboring countries, especially about History, Culture, Geography, Economic Scene, General policy, and scientific research.

### **SSC CHSL Syllabus 2024 For Computer Knowledge**

- **Computer Basics:** Organization of a computer, Central Processing Unit (CPU), input/ output devices, computer memory, memory organization, backup devices, PORTs, Windows Explorer, and Keyboard shortcuts.
- **Software:** Windows Operating system including basics of Microsoft Office like MS Word, MS Excel, and PowerPoint, etc.
- **Working with the Internet and e-mails:** Web Browsing and searching, Downloading and uploading, Managing an E-mail Account, e-banking.
- **Basics of networking and cyber security:** Networking devices and protocols, Network and information security threats (like hacking, viruses, worms, Trojans, etc.), and preventive measures.

### **Skill test for Data Entry Operator**

In this test, a candidate must have a data entry speed of 8,000 (eight thousand) Key Impressions per hour. The duration of the Test will be 15 minutes and an English document having about 2000-2200 strokes/key depressions will be given to type.

The Skill Test will be conducted for Data Entry Operators only. The typing test will be conducted for other posts i.e. LDC/ JSA.

**For Skill Test:**

- Module II of Section III will include the Skill Test/ Typing Test in Session II on the same day.
- Skill Test/ Typing Test will be qualifying.
- Errors in the Skill Test will be calculated up to 2 decimal places.
- Skill Test is mandatory for Data Entry Operators. No candidate is exempted from appearing in the Skill Test.

**For Typing Test:**

- The medium of the Typing Test will be Hindi or English.
- The candidates will have to opt for the medium of Typing Test i.e. either Hindi or English in the online Application Form.
- The choice of Typing Test during the application form will be final. There will be no change in the medium of the Typing Test.
- Candidates opting for English medium should have a typing speed of 35 words per minute (w.p.m.)
- The candidates opting for Hindi medium should have a typing speed of 30 words per minute (w.p.m.)
- The speed will be adjudged on the accuracy of typing on the Computer of a given text passage in 10 minutes.
