	 About Athikadavu Avinashi scheme: The scheme aims to recharge groundwater in drought-prone and groundwater-depleted areas in the districts of Erode, Tiruppur, and Coimbatore. It involves the diversion of surplus water from the Bhavani river to various water bodies, including lakes, ponds, and other water bodies. The scheme includes the construction of check dams, percolation ponds, and tanks to store and utilize water effectively.
Innuyir Kappom - Nammai Kaakkum 48	 Why in the news? The State government's scheme, 'Innuyir Kappom - Nammai Kaakkum 48', was launched by Chief Minister M.K. Stalin in December 2021. More than 2.54 lakh persons have benefitted from this scheme.

	 About TNPCB: Establishment: The Tamil Nadu Pollution Control Board (TNPCB) was established in 1982 under the provisions of the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974. Headquarters: Chennai, Tamil Nadu. Primary Objective: To prevent, control, and abate pollution in the state of Tamil Nadu. It enforces the provisions of The Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, The Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981, The Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules made under these Acts. It lays down standards for sewage/trade effluent and emissions.
Palar river	 Why in the news? The Tamil Nadu Pollution Control Board (TNPCB) imposes ₹2.6 lakh fine on tannery near Vaniyambadi for discharge of effluents into Palar river. About Palar river: Location: Originates in the Nandi Hills of Karnataka, flows through the states of Karnataka, Andhra Pradesh, and Tamil Nadu, and empties into the Bay of Bengal. Tributaries: Major tributaries include the Cheyyar River, the Agaram Aru, and the Poini River.

Integrated Goods and Services
Tax (IGST)

Why in the news?

The Tax Research Unit set up by the Commercial Taxes **Department** has **helped Tamil Nadu recover ₹1,523.95** crore under the Integrated Goods and Services Tax (IGST).

About IGST:

- IGST is one of the three components of the Goods and Services Tax (GST) in India, the other two being Central GST (CGST) and State GST (SGST).
- It is governed by the Integrated Goods and Services Tax Act, 2017.
- Purpose:
 - o IGST is levied on inter-state transactions of goods and services, including imports into India.
 - o It ensures that the tax burden is shared between the central and state governments.
- Levy and Collection:
 - IGST is collected by the central government.
 - o The revenue generated is shared between the central and state governments based on the destination principle.
