The temple also houses shrines for other forms of Vishnu, including Narasimha, Rama, Ranganatha, and Varadaraja. Historical Significance: One of the oldest temples in Chennai, dating back to the Pallava period (8th century). Built by Pallava king Narasimhavarman I. Architecture: Dravidian style architecture. Features five main shrines, each dedicated to a form of Vishnu. Notable for its tall, intricately carved gopurams (gateway towers).
