

10 Community: (a) The applicants belonging to SC & ST are required to produce Community Certificate issued by the competent authority (obtained from Government of Telangana State) in terms of G.O.Ms No. 58, SW (J) Dept., dt: 12/5/97 read with G.O. Ms. No. 5 Scheduled Castes Development (POA.A2) Dept., dt. 08/08/2014, G.O. Ms. No. 11 Scheduled Castes Development (POA.A2) Dept., dt. 17/09/2014 and G.O. Ms. No. 2 Scheduled Castes Development (POA.A2) Dept., dt. 22/01/2015. As per Rule-2(29) of T.S. State and Subordinate Service Rules. Explanation: No person who professes a religion different from Hinduism, the Sikh or Buddhism shall be deemed to be as member of a Scheduled Caste. (b) The applicants belonging to Backward Classes are required to produce Community Certificate (BC-A, BC-B, BC-C, BC-D & BC-E) issued by the Competent Authority in the State of Telangana obtained through Mee Seva vide G.O. Ms. No. 16 BCW (OP) Dept., Dt. 11/03/2015. (c) Income Certificate for claiming EWS Reservation issued by the Tahsildar (Government of Telangana) vide G.O. Ms. No. 244 General Administration (Ser.D) Department, Dt. 24/08/2021 and orders and instructions issued by the Government from time to time.

11 Reservation: -

- i) The Rule of Reservation is applicable in terms of General Rule 22 & 22 (A) of Telangana State and Subordinate Service Rules.
- ii) Rule of Reservation is not applicable for Pc. No - 01 i.e., for the post of Professors.
- iii) Reservation to Disabled persons is subject to the Special Rules/Adhoc Rules governing the posts. The extent of Disability will be decided by the State Appellate Medical Authorities.
- iv) If eligible disabled women applicants of VH(W) / HH(W) / OH(W) / MH(W) category are not available in the initial recruitment, the same shall be filled up by the eligible Male applicants with same category of disability respectively as per G.O.MS. No. 96 General Administration (Ser.D) Department, Dt. 22/07/2019. Hence, eligible male applicants of VH/ HH/ OH/ MH disabled category can also apply for the posts meant for Women categories.
- v) For Carry Forward PH vacancies, if eligible disabled applicants of that particular category are not available, the same shall be filled up by the method of interchanging as per G.O.MS. No. 96 General Administration (Ser.D) Department, Dt. 22/07/2019. Hence, applicants of all the disabled categories can apply.
- vi) Reservation to BC-E group as per G.O. Ms. No. 23 Backward Classes Welfare (C.2) Department, Dt. 07/07/2007, will be subject to the adjudication of the litigation before the Honorable Courts including final orders in Civil Appeal No: (a) 2628-2637 of 2010 in SLP. No. 7388-97 of 2010, dated. 25/03/2010 and orders from the Government.
- vii) The reservation to Meritorious Sports Person is applicable as per the amendments made to State and Subordinate Service Rules as per G.O.Ms.No.107, General Administration (Ser.D) Dept., Dt. 27-07-2018 that is in Rule-2, for sub-Rule (20) and in Rule-22 (i) in sub-Rule (2), for Class-D. In implementing the reservation to Meritorious Sports Person as per G.O. Ms. No.05 YAT&C(Sports) Department, Dt. 14/05/2018, or as may be revised by the Government from time to time shall be followed.
- viii) **Economically Weaker Sections:-** The EWS reservation is applicable as per G.O. Ms. No. 243 & 244 GA (SER.D) Dept., Dt. 24/08/2021.

Note:-Applicants producing Certificates issued by the Competent Authorities in Telangana State alone are eligible to claim various reservations like SC/ST/BC/ EWS/PH etc.

PARA-V: Reservation to the Local candidates is not applicable as the selection will be made on state-wide merit.

Joint Projects: Principal Investigator and Co-investigator would get 50% each.

Note:

- Paper presented if part of edited book or proceeding, then it can be claimed only once.
- For joint supervision of research students, the formula shall be 70% of the total score for Supervisor and Co-supervisor. Supervisor and Co-supervisor, both shall get 7 marks each.

(a) Award of Ph.D.: 10 points for single Supervisor

(b) Award of Ph.D. by joint Supervision: 7 points each (Supervisor and Co-Supervisor)

(c) For submission of Ph.D. thesis: 5 points for Single Supervisor and 3.5 points to each in case of Joint Supervisors (i.e., Supervisor and Co-Supervisor).

*For the purpose of calculating research score of the teacher, the combined research score from the categories of 5(b).Policy Document and 6.Invited lectures/Resource Person/Paper presentation shall have an upper capping of thirty percent of the total research score of the teacher concerned.

The research score shall be from the minimum of three categories out of six categories.
