What is the Kafala System?

- It is a sponsorship system that binds migrant workers to one employer
- It is practiced in many countries of West Asia Like Gulf countries
- It emerged in the 1950s
- objective to provide temporary and rotating laborers in the period of economic boom.
- The Kafala system based on migrant workers, employer and contractual period
- A migrant worker is legally bound to his employer.
- A worker cannot enter or leave the country without permission of the employer

The FATF is a policy-making body that works with governments to bring about national legislation and regulatory reforms in these areas.
