

Key facts

- AP govt has constituted a steering committee to frame the guidelines on transforming education.
- The committee **defined the roadmap** for transforming the State Boards of Education.
- The syllabus will be implemented at SSC and Intermediate level.
- AP government has passed GO 81 to synchronize the AP Board's education system with the globally recognised IB standards

- 3. Extended Essay.

In News:

CAG felt that the formation of the Ward Secretariat system in AP is against the spirit of the Constitution.

Key points:

 According to CAG, formation of Ward Secretariats at the ward level without the formation of Ward Committees diluted the spirit of the Constitution as envisaged for local self-governance.

About the ward secretariat

AP govt formed Ward Secretariats on October 2, 2019, one for every two thousand population across the state.

Key facts • Manuals aimed at safeguarding snakes, mangroves, and sea turtles. • These guides were officially launched at the Aranya Bhavan in Mangalagiri. • The first manual has been formulated in collaboration with the Eastern Ghats Wildlife Society, a local NGO and Romulus Whitaker. • The manual will establish guidelines for snake rescuers and promote a certificate program to regulate their activities within the state. • Other two manuals are related to mangroves and sea turtles. Did you Know? Mangrove occurs in Andhra Pradesh in estuaries of Krishna and Godavari rivers on around 9% of local forest area of the State.

- He was born in Kumbakonam, Tamil Nadu, India.
- Through his work in the 1960s and 1970s, he revolutionized the Indian agricultural sector, turning it towards self-sufficiency.

Green Revolution

Key Points:

- The Green Revolution in India was a period of rapid agricultural growth that began in the 1960s.
- The revolution was driven by the introduction of high-yielding varieties (HYVs) of seeds, irrigation facilities, pesticides, and fertilizers.
- The HYV seeds were developed by scientists at the International Rice Research Institute (IRRI) in the Philippines and the International Maize and Wheat Improvement Center (CIMMYT) in Mexico..
