TS Govt's Free Palliative Care



In News:

Telangana government, collaborated voluntary with organizations to expand the crucial palliative care facilities in all the 33 districts

Key Points:

- Palliative care is care meant to improve the quality of life of patients who have a serious or life-threatening disease, such as cancer.
- Mainly benefits the **weaker sections** who cannot afford.
- Trained field level healthcare workers, including Accredited Social Health Activists (ASHA workers), are providing home care services to patients.
- Each palliative care facility has a doctor, five nurses, a physiotherapist, a driver, and five non-clinical staff.
- The state government is incurring an expenditure of Rs 30-35 lakh for each free palliative care facility.

Model code of conduct



In News:

The Model Code of Conduct has come into force in five states -Chhattisgarh, Mizoram, Madhya Pradesh, Rajasthan and **Telangana** – which will go to the polls next month. **Key facts**

- Model Code of Conduct (MCC) is a set of guidelines issued by the Election Commission of India (ECI) for political parties and candidates to follow during elections.
- It aims to ensure fair and peaceful elections.

Guidelines of the MCC:

- Maintain peace and harmony: Refrain from using language or actions that could incite violence or hatred.
- Avoid personal criticism: Focus on the policies and programs of other parties and candidates, rather than their personal lives.
- Refrain from appealing to caste or religious sentiments: Do not use religion, caste, or other sensitive topics to influence voters.
- Do not use places of worship for election propaganda: Places of worship should be respected and not used for political campaigning.

- Strictly prohibit corrupt practices: This includes bribing voters, intimidating voters, and canvassing near polling stations.
- Respect individuals' privacy and homes: Do not organize demonstrations or picketing outside people's homes.
- Cooperate with election officials: Provide identity badges to authorized workers and refrain from serving or distributing liquor on polling day.

In News:

Transport Minister Puvvada Ajay Kumar launched several development works worth Rs.15.10 crore in Bhadrachalam town.

Facts:

- Bhadradri Bhadrachalam is a census town in Kothagudem district of Telangana, India.
- It is situated on the banks of the Godavari River, 312 km east of Hyderabad, the state capital.
- Bhadrachalam is an important Hindu pilgrimage town, home to the famous Bhadrachalam Temple of Lord Rama.



State cultivates paddy in more area than Punjab



In News:

Telangana's Finance and Health Minister T Harish Rao claimed that the state has been witnessing bumper harvest in the last two years, thanks to the Kaleshwaram Lift Irrigation Scheme (KLIS).

Key Points:

- He said that Telangana now has more area under paddy cultivation than **Punjab**.
- The Kaleshwaram project has changed the face of the state, bringing irrigation water to every village.

Key Facts of KLIS:

- Multi-purpose irrigation project on the Godavari River in Kaleshwaram, Bhupalpally, Telangana.
- The project starts at the confluence point of Pranahita River and Godavari River.
- Originally called Pranahita-Chevella project in erstwhile Andhra Pradesh, it was redesigned, extended and renamed as Kaleshwaram project in Telangana in 2014.

Phase-II commission drinking water in Telangana

In News:

The ORR Phase-II project is a water supply project in Hyderabad, India, that is expected to partially open on Monday.

Key Points:

- The project includes the construction of 13 water reservoirs, 73 Ground Level Storage Reservoirs (GLSR), and a new pipeline system of 2,988 km.
- The project will provide adequate drinking water to thousands of water consumers living outside GHMC and within ORR limits.
- It will improve the per capita water supply from 75 to 100 LPCD to 150 LPCD, enhance water supply into the system, improve service level benchmarks for the existing consumers, and cover the unserved areas.
- The project is being taken up under two packages:
 - Package-I: Saroornagar, Maheshwaram. Shamshabad, Hayathnagar, Ibrahimpatnam, Ghatkesar and Keesara mandals
 - Package-II: Rajendranagar, Shamirpet, Medchal, Qutubullapur, RC Puram, Patancheru and Bolarum mandals.

Telangana governor attends FDDI annual convention in Gachibowli



In news:

Telangana Governor Tamilisai Soundararajan attended the FDDI (Footwear Design and Development Institute) Annual Convention in Gachibowli.

Key points:

- The event featured prominent figures like designer Asmita Marwa and FDDI Director Pankaj Kumar Sinha.
- Governor awarded gold medals to students who excelled in fashion designing, footwear design, and other categories.
- She also emphasized the importance of addressing **anemia** in children, attributing it to the presence of **tiny** parasites in the body which are probably transmitted from legs.
