Vizag to get 200 Electric buses	 In news: Andhra Pradesh State Road Transport Corporation (APSRTC) is taking steps to reduce its carbon footprint by introducing electric air-conditioned buses in Visakhapatnam. Key points: Currently, electric buses are operational between Nellore and Tirupati cities, and the RTC plans to procure a total of 1,000 electric buses. The APSRTC is proposing to introduce 200 electric buses in Visakhapatnam, with an initial deployment of 100 buses in the first phase. Three bus depots in Visakhapatnam (Simhapuri, Gajuwaka, and Waltair) will be equipped with charging

Palnadu becomes Anemia free district Bangaru Thalli Scheme	 In news: Bangaru Thalli scheme to make Palnadu anemia-free, addressing the issue of low hemoglobin levels. Objective: To take care of a girl child in every household from birth to graduation. Under the scheme, monthly blood tests will be conducted to assess students' hemoglobin levels, categorizing them as normal, mild, moderate, or severe. The scheme includes providing nutritious meals at government schools and distributing iron-rich IAF tablets to combat anemia. pregnant and lactating women benefit from the Take Home Ration scheme
Jagananna Civil Services Potsahakam	 In news: The Andhra Pradesh government has introduced the Jagananna Civil Services Potsahakam to support civil services aspirants from socially, educationally, and economically weaker sections. Key Points: The scheme offers financial assistance to qualified aspirants, providing Rs 1 lakh for those who clear the preliminary exam and Rs 50,000 for those who pass the Mains exam, with these incentives available for multiple attempts. The program is aimed at increasing the number of civil services selections. Eligibility criteria: Aspirants who belong to socially, educationally, and economically weaker sections with a family income below Rs 8 lakh per annum and limited land holdings.
