Rajasekhara is a small, herbaceous plant that typically grows to a height of about 30 cm. Rajasekhara is a very rare plant and is only found in a few isolated locations in the Eastern Ghats.

The door delivery service is available in 84 cities of Andhra Pradesh, including deliveries from Hyderabad. Door delivery is only available for booking purposes and not for direct delivery in Hyderabad. There are a total of 64 booking agencies in the city.
