|  | <ul> <li>About Caste Census:</li> <li>A caste census is a census that enumerates the population of a country or region by caste.</li> <li>Caste censuses have been conducted in India on several occasions, including in 1931, 1981, and 2011.</li> <li>The 2011 caste census was the first comprehensive caste census conducted in India since 1981.</li> <li>The census collected data on the population of all Scheduled Castes (SCs) and Scheduled Tribes (STs), as well as on Other Backward Classes (OBCs).</li> <li>The census also collected data on the educational attainment, occupational status, and economic status of these groups.</li> <li>The results of the 2011 caste census have not yet been released.</li> <li>However, the census data is expected to provide valuable insights into the social and economic status of different caste groups in India.</li> </ul> |

|         | <ul> <li>It is a low-pressure, low-flow-rate irrigation<br/>system that applies water directly to the root zone of<br/>plants.</li> </ul>  |
|         | <ul> <li>This type of irrigation is more efficient than conventional sprinkler systems because it reduces evaporation and runoff.</li> <li>Micro irrigation systems can be used to irrigate a wide</li> </ul>  |
