INS Dega:

- INS Dega is a **naval air station of the Indian Navy**.
- It is located in Visakhapatnam, Andhra Pradesh, on the east coast of India.
- It is **named after the Telugu word "Dega", which means a big and powerful bird of the eagle family**.
- INS Dega was commissioned in 1991 and is one of the most important naval air stations in India.
- It is home to a variety of aircraft, including Sea Harrier fighter jets, Chetak helicopters, and Dornier reconnaissance aircraft.
- INS Dega also plays an important role in training naval pilots and aircrew.
