T-Fiber



Context:

- Telangana Fiber Grid Corporation Ltd. (T-Fiber) is a state-owned special purpose vehicle (SPV) established by the Government of Telangana
- Aim is to implement a comprehensive fiber optic network across the state.
- The T-Fiber project also aims to provide high-speed broadband connectivity to every household, government institution, and private enterprise in Telangana.

Key objectives of T-Fiber:

- Bridge the digital divide in Telangana by providing universal broadband access
- Facilitate the growth of the IT industry and e-governance initiatives
- Enhance education, healthcare, and other social services through digital connectivity
- Drive economic development and job creation by fostering a digital economy

Project scope and infrastructure:

- The T-Fiber project will deploy a network of optical fiber cables (OFC) to connect all 10 zones, 31 districts, 584 mandals, 8,778 gram panchayats, and 10,128 villages in Telangana.
- The network will leverage existing infrastructure, such as RoW (Right of Way) and trenching created under the Mission Bhagiratha water supply project.
