History & Significance

- Constitution Day, also known as **Samvidhan Divas** or **National Law Day**, is celebrated in India on **November 26th** every year.
- It commemorates the adoption of the Constitution of India by the Constituent Assembly on **November 26, 1949**.
- The Constitution came into effect on **January 26, 1950**.
- The Constitution of India was created by **Dr. B.R. Ambedkar**, the chairman of the Drafting Committee.
- The Constitution took **2 years, 11 months, and 18 days to create**.
- It provides a framework to govern the country while considering its **social, cultural, and religious diversity**.

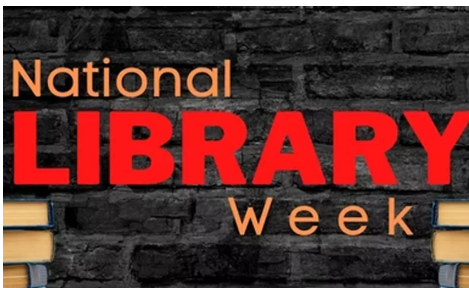
Kanipakam temple



Context:

- AP govt is giving Top priority to the development of Kanipakam temple
- It is an ancient Hindu temple **dedicated to Lord Ganesha**, located in Chittoor district of Andhra Pradesh, India.
- The temple is **renowned for its Swayambhu (self-manifested) idol of Lord Ganesha**, which is said to be **continuously growing in size**.
- The temple is believed to have been **constructed in the early 11th century CE by the Chola king Kulothunga I** and was **expanded further in 1336 by the Vijayanagara dynasty rulers**.

National Library Week



Context:

- **National Library Week** is an **annual** celebration in India that highlights the valuable role libraries, librarians, and library workers play in transforming lives and strengthening communities.
- It is observed from **November 14 to 20** every year to **commemorate the establishment of the Indian Library Association (ILA) on November 14, 1912**.
- **November 14** is the **birth anniversary** of first prime minister of India **Jawaharlal Nehru**, which is marked as **Children's Day**.

Atal Tinkering Labs

Context:

- **Atal Tinkering Labs (ATLs)** are **innovation spaces established by the Atal Innovation Mission (AIM), NITI Aayog**, in schools across India to cultivate a culture of innovation and creativity among students.



- In Andhra Pradesh, ATLS have been set up in various government and private schools to provide students with hands-on learning experiences in emerging technologies like robotics, 3D printing, electronics, and IoT (Internet of Things).
- Atal Tinkering Labs are working with the aim of nurturing young brains on creating innovations.

Andhra Pradesh 'caste census' to begin on Dec. 9

Context:

- Caste Census in AP will begin from Dec 9 and various caste representatives from across the State will be consulted for the exercise.
- The census would be undertaken in a **“scientific” manner**.
- The exercise is important as it would change the social and economic status of the poor.

National award for 'Jagananna Gorumudda'



Context:

- **'Jagananna Gorumudda'**, a program that provides nutritious food to children studying in government schools, has received national recognition.
- It was awarded the **National First Prize** for its exceptional services for the prevention of anemia among adolescent students.
- The initiative is **led by the Union Ministry of Women and Child Welfare**
