- It provides a framework to govern the country while considering its social, cultural, and religious diversity.


Kanipakam temple



Context:

- AP govt is giving Top priority to the development of Kanipakam temple
- It is an ancient Hindu temple dedicated to Lord Ganesha. located in Chittoor district of Andhra Pradesh, India.
- The temple is renowned for its Swayambhu (self-manifested) idol of Lord Ganesha, which is said to be continuously growing in size.
- The temple is believed to have been constructed in the early 11th century CE by the Chola king Kulothunga I and was expanded further in 1336 by the Vijayanagara dynasty rulers.

- National Library Week is an annual celebration in India that highlights the valuable role libraries, librarians, and library workers play in transforming lives and strengthening communities.
- It is observed from November 14 to 20 every year to commemorate the establishment of the Indian Library Association (ILA) on November 14, 1912.
- November 14 is the birth anniversary of first prime minister of India Jawaharlal Nehru, which is marked as Children's Day.
