Armed Forces Flag Day	<ul> <li>Armed Forces Flag Day on December 7 honors soldiers, sailors, and airmen for safeguarding borders and ensuring peace at the cost of their lives.</li> <li>Armed Forces Flag Day, established on August 28, 1949, serves as a remembrance and fundraising initiative by the Ministry of Defence.</li> <li>Citizens contribute by purchasing badges and stickers on this day, with funds aimed at improving armed forces personnel's lives.</li> <li>Funds raised are crucial for providing better facilities and resources to selfless soldiers, sailors, and airmen.</li> </ul>
India backs UN resolution against Israel for not leaving Syrian Golan	<ul> <li>Context <ul> <li>India has voted in favour of a draft resolution in the United Nations General Assembly (UNGA) that expressed deep concern over Israel not withdrawing from the Syrian Golan.</li> <li>The Syrian Golan is a region in southwest Syria that was occupied by Israeli forces on June 5, 1967.</li> <li>The resolution also stressed the illegality of the Israeli settlement construction in the Golan.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
Muslim student strength in higher education fell by 1.79 lakh in 2020-21	<ul> <li>Context</li> <li>Report based on analysis of UDISE+ and AISHE data shows: <ul> <li>Muslim student enrolment in higher education (18-23 age group) dropped over 8.5% in 2020-21.</li> <li>This Reflects a significant decline in educational participation among Muslim youth.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Key points <ul> <li>While 21 lakh Muslim students enrolled for higher education in 2019-20, the number fell to 19.21 lakh in 2020-21.</li> <li>The enrolment percentage of Muslim students in Classes 11 and 12 is lower than that in the previous classes.</li> <li>The States such as Bihar and Madhya Pradesh have relatively low Gross Enrolment Ratio for Muslim students</li> <li>Assam (29.52%) and West Bengal (23.22%) recorded high dropout rates among Muslim students, while Jammu and Kashmir recorded 5.1% and Kerala 11.91%.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>



	<ul> <li>Key points <ul> <li>India will be sending a total of five lifters, including two women.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Ajith Narayan and Achinta Sheuli will be in the men's 73 kg.</li> <li>Mirabai Chanu will be attending the event for a weigh-in.</li> <li>Bindyarani Devi will figure in the non-Olympic women's 55kg weight division while Gurdeep Singh will be in action in the +109kg, another non-Olympic weight division.</li> </ul>
