<p>Centre includes 31 AP dams in DRIP II & III</p>	<p>Context:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Centre has included 31 dams of Andhra Pradesh in the Dam Rehabilitation and Improvement Project (DRIP) II and III phases for their rehabilitation and safety improvement with an outlay of Rs 667 crore. • The State government has so far prepared the rehabilitation proposals for three projects -- Sir Arthur Cotton Barrage, Srisailam and Raiwada Reservoir, and submitted them to the Central Water Commission for getting the approval of the World Bank.
<p>Foundation laid for development works at Durga temple</p>	<p>Context:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • CM lays foundation for Rs 216 cr development works at Durga temple • Besides laying the foundation, he also inaugurated Rs 70 crore worth of projects which were completed. • He also inaugurated eight temples which were renovated at a cost of Rs 4 crore.
<p>Crime against women rose by 43%</p>	<p>Context:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Crime against women has seen a staggering rise in AP as the State has recorded a 43 per cent increase in cases in 2022, compared to 2021 • It thus places Andhra Pradesh in sixth place. • According to the National Crime Records Bureau's (NCRB), Crime in India-2022 report, which was released by the Ministry of Home Affairs on Monday, the State had reported as many as 25,503 cases of crime against women in 2022, against 17,752 in 2021. • With atleast 70 cases reported every day, the crimes include dowry deaths, rape, abetment of suicide, atrocities against children, cruelty by husband, sexual harassment and others.

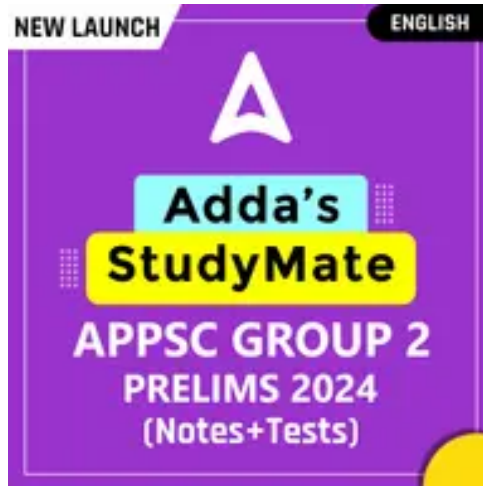
Four projects in Machilipatnam finished
