<p><b>Ts govt to provide LPG at ₹ 500</b></p>	<p><b>Context:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● <b>Ts govt</b> is implementing its promises of <b>providing LPG cylinder at ₹500 and bonus of ₹500 per a quintal of paddy</b>, forming part of the party's six guarantees within hundred days of coming to power.</li><li>● <b>List of beneficiaries under the Mahalakshmi scheme</b> envisaging provision of gas cylinders at <b>₹500</b> will be out soon.</li></ul>
<p><b>Telangana's economy growing faster than India's</b></p> 	<p><b>Context:</b> Telangana's economy is outpacing the national average, with a <b>GSDP growth of 7.8% at constant prices and 16.3% at current prices in 2022-23</b>.</p> <p><b>Key Points:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● At constant prices, Telangana's GSDP was Rs 7,26,707 crore, contributing to 4.5% of India's GDP, with a growth rate of <b>7.8% compared to India's 7.2%</b>.</li><li>● From 2012-13 to 2022-23, Telangana's average annual growth rate was 6.7%, surpassing India's 5.7%. Between 2014-15 and 2022-23, Telangana's average annual growth rate was 7.3%, exceeding India's 5.7%.</li><li>● Telangana leads in per capita income, reaching Rs 3,12,398, making it the top state among large states and</li></ul>

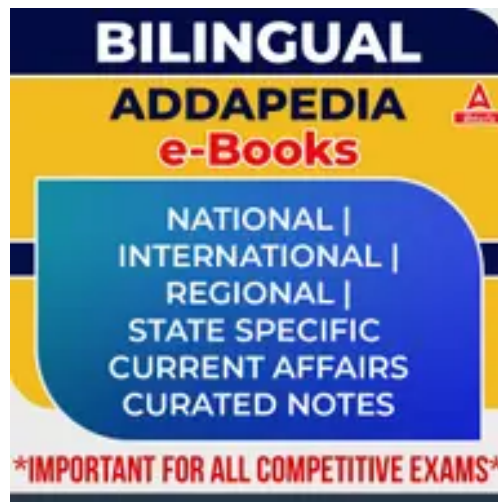
